- APAC SWIM target implementation : 2024 – 2030
- Cessation of FPL2012 and transition to FF-ICE
 - APAC : 2032
 - Global : 2034
- APAC Regional FF-ICE/R1 Implementation Plan
SWIM information services should be used to provide more details of applicable restrictions
 - Aerodrome, airspace, and route availability
 - ATFM measures
 - Environmental conditions
 - etc.
