Context and Key gap

Rapid Growth, Increasing Pressure

- APAC = ~40% of global airspace
- Fastest-growing aviation region

Key Issue

- Lowest EI scores in AIG
- Major gap in investigator training (CE4)
 - ➔ Training is a critical constraint




Core challenges

- Delays in investigation reports
- Limited resources & skilled personnel
- Technical capability gaps
- Weak coordination
- ➔ Challenge is implementation, not regulation



What's needed

- Foundations for effectiveness
- Independence of investigation bodies
- Strong State-level support
- Practical implementation focus
- Plus:  Timely, credible communication



Cooperation and Training

No authority can do this alone

- Resource sharing
- Mutual support
- Regional cooperation (e.g. ENCASIA model)

Training reality

- Years to build competence
- Technical + professional judgement

 **Need regional approaches to training**



Safety Recommendations

Where impact happens

- Start of a **continuous dialogue**
- Must be:
 - Clear & targeted
 - Realistic & actionable

Key challenges

- Monitoring & follow-up
- Correct addressee
- Coordination AIB ↔ CAA

 **Implementation depends on dialogue**



From Investigation to Impact

- Moving forward
- Better tracking of actions
- Stronger coordination mechanisms
- Use of data for trend analysis
- ➔ Shift to safety intelligence



Industry Cooperation

- Effective investigation requires partnership
 - Strong consensus across the panel:
 - Cooperation between AIBs, regulators, and industry is essential
 - Critical for both:
 - Conducting investigations
 - Implementing safety recommendations
 - Industry contribution is indispensable
- **Independence does not mean isolation**
- **Effective safety = independence + cooperation**



Key takeaways

- Ensure independence + State support
- Invest in training
- Focus on implementation
- Strengthen regional cooperation
- Deliver real safety improvements
