AIR TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT POINTS OF CONTACT FOR SAIOSEACG MEETING

SUMMARY

This paper presents the requirements for ATM Points of Contact for SAIOSEACG meeting listed at the Asia/Pacific Regional Sub-Office, and requests that administrations nominate responsible officer to establish and maintain this information.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Since 2005 the Regional Office has maintained a contact list to operational safety matters in accordance with the following APANPIRG Conclusion:

Conclusion 16/62 – State focal point for safety-related activities

That, Asia/Pacific States notify to the Regional Office by the first quarter of 2006 a responsible contact officer or position to act as a focal point for safety related activities and in particular for the submission and coordination of ATS incident reports.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 Conclusion 16/62 required the nomination by States of a Contact Officer or position to act as the Points of Contact (POC) for ATS safety-related activities. In the context of this meeting, the Secretariat requires nominations to populate the POC list specifically for the South Asia, Indian Ocean and the Southeast Asia (SAIOSEACG) sub-region.

2.2 From time to time the Regional Office needs to contact State aeronautical authorities on issues including, but not limited to ATS routes and airspace or other Air Navigation Services (ANS) aspects of the Regional Air Navigation Plan.

2.3 The ATM Points of Contact List is intended to be a consolidated resource for SAIOSEACG members, including, inter alia, Administrative, Aeronautical Information Service (AIS), Asia/Pacific Region ATS Route Catalogue (ARC), Air Traffic Control (ATC) and Safety - Airspace Safety Monitoring and FIT (SAF) POCs.

2.4 To ensure the list remains current, the Secretariat requests that administrations provide their nominations to populate the list. The List will be separately circulated by the Secretariat to all registered participants for update. The meeting is invited to nominate the ATM Points of Contact List for SAIOSEACG meeting, providing details by email to apac-rso@icao.int, with a copy to yanruchen@icao.int.
