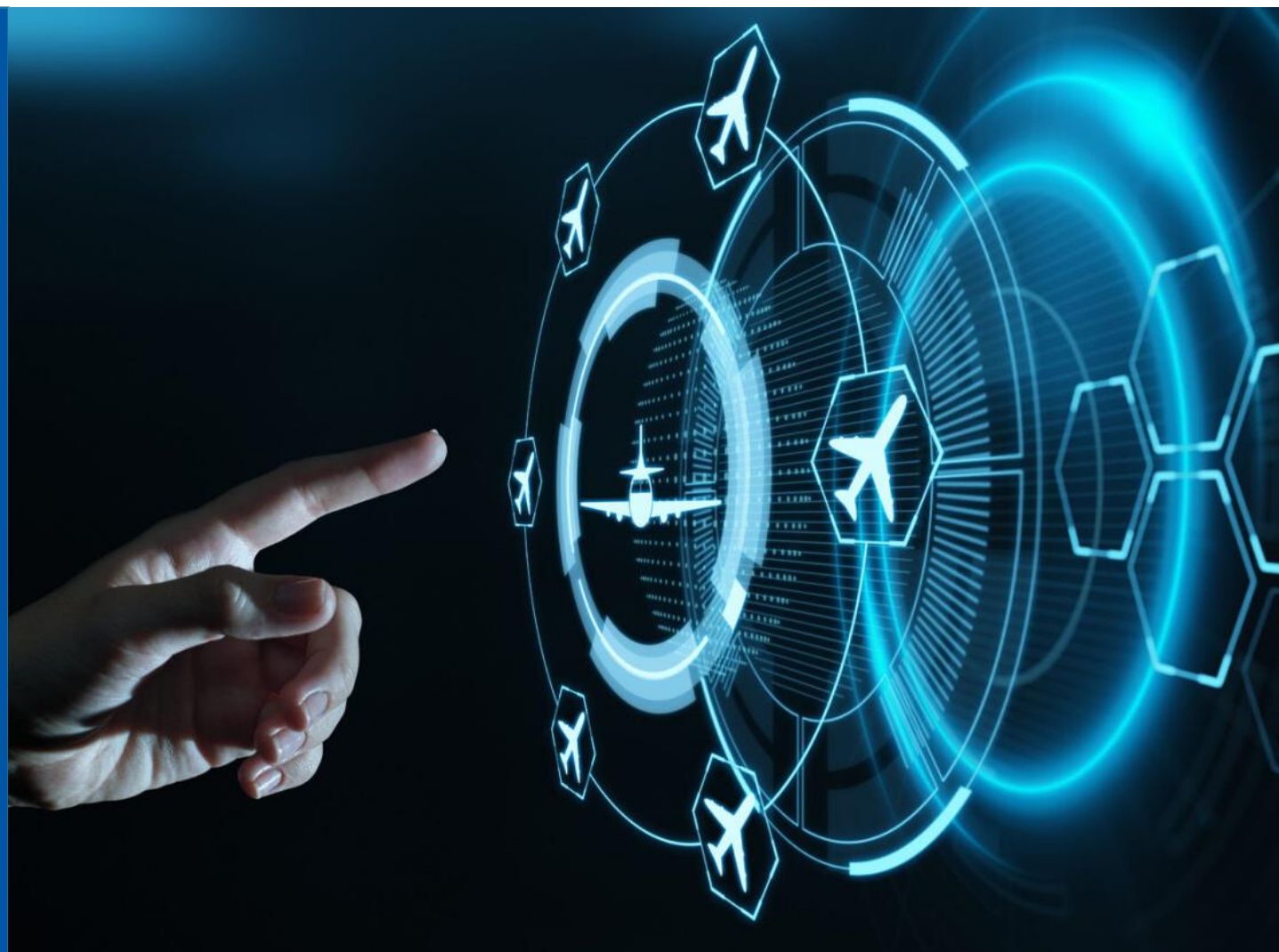

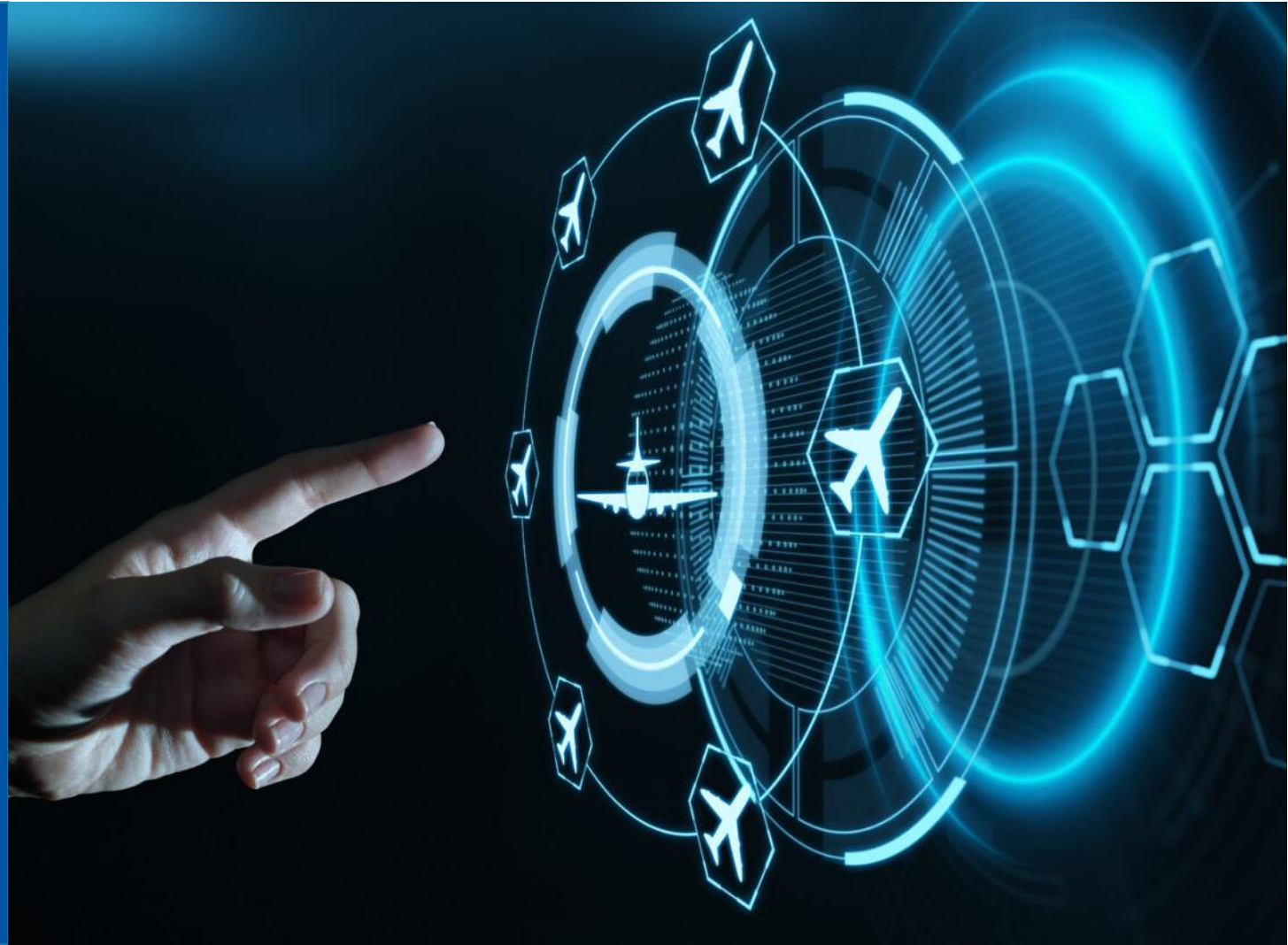

ANS Reporting Tool- 2024

- ✓ The Seamless ANS Plan Reporting Tool was launched in 2024.
- ✓ The ICAO Workshop on APAC Seamless ANS Reporting Tool - 17 to 19 April 2024, ICAO APAC Regional Office.
- ✓ APANPIRG/34 **Conclusion APANPIRG/34/1** - APAC Regional Seamless ANS Reporting Form 3.0 and Cloud-based Seamless ANS Implementation Progress Reporting and
- ✓ **Conclusion APANPIRG/34/2** - ICAO HQ Support for Regional ANS Implementation for the reporting of Seamless ANS implementation progress through the Reporting Portal by not later than 30th June 2024, and then at least once a year by not later than 28th February each year
- ✓ 17 Asia/Pacific States/Administrations (representing 41.5% of the total) had submitted some form of reporting via the new Seamless ANS Reporting Tool till CNS SG/28 (01-05 July 2024).
- ✓ CNS SG/28 Meeting requested States/Administrations to update information in the tool.
- ✓ The ICAO Secretariat was working with the ICAO HQ IT team to improve the tool's functionality. **ACTION ITEM 28-12** It was suggested that when States use the tool, they can share their suggestion for its improvement. Based on users' recommendations and needs, more features can be incorporated into the tool's functionality

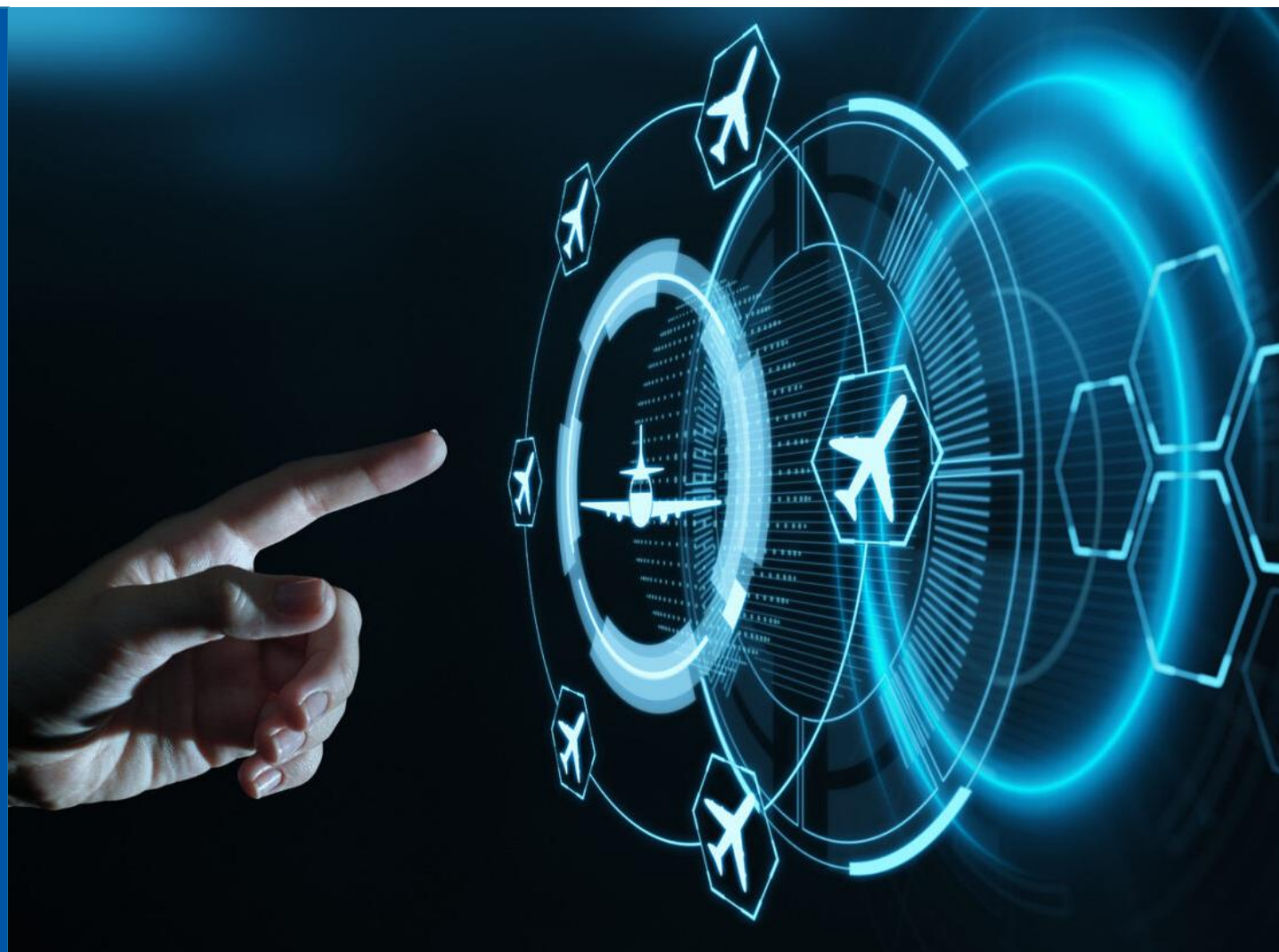

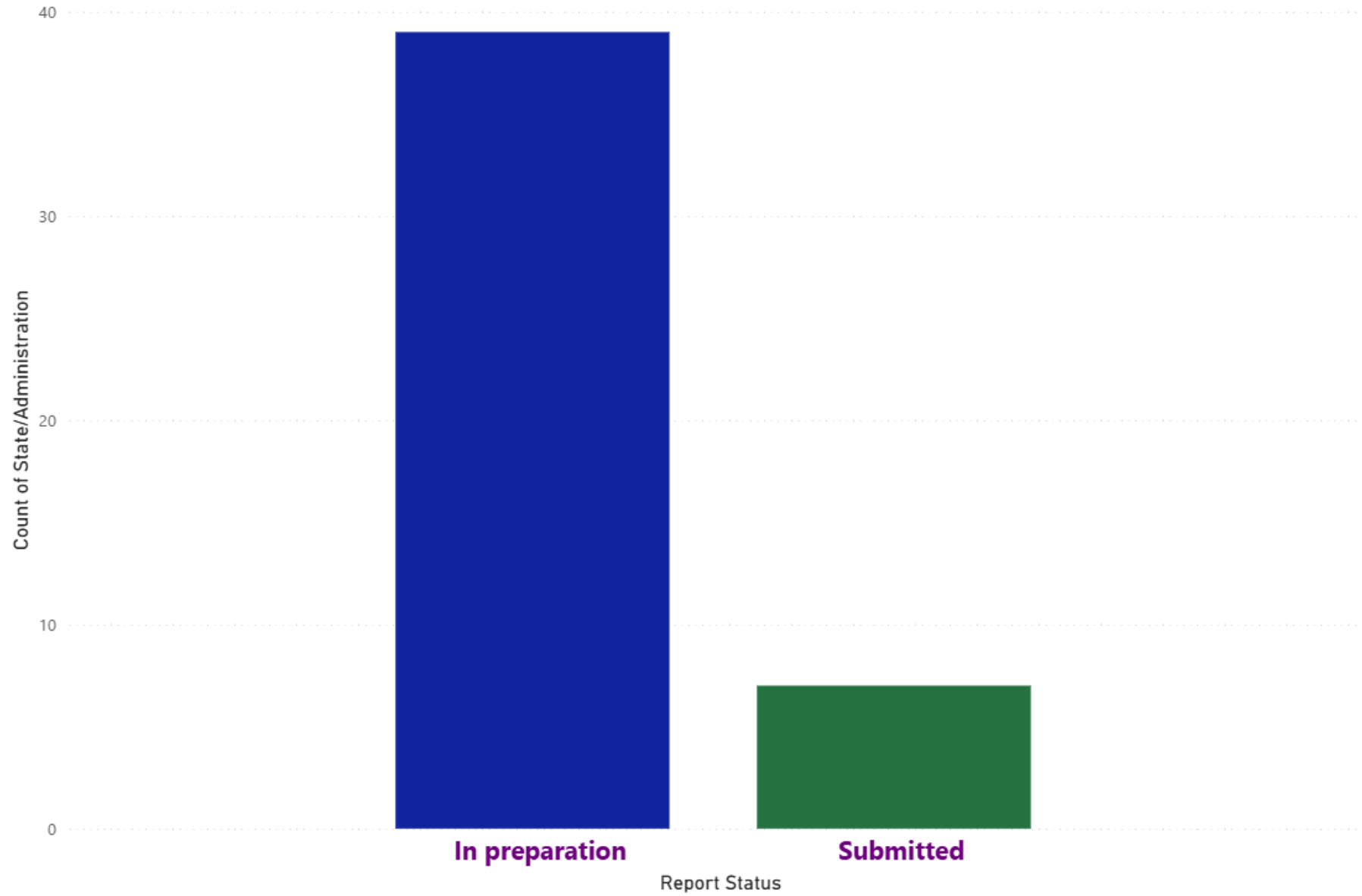
ANS Reporting Tool- 2025

.29-9	A question was asked about the expectation to submit reporting by States / Administrations once a year or twice, as in the ANS Reporting Tool currently, the report period is the first half of a year and the second half of a year. It was informed that ICAO expects States to submit updates up to the end of last year “at least once annually”, preferably before 28 February of the year. It was added that the report period column would be modified so that States/Administrations could submit updates at least once annually	CNS SG/30	ICAO Secretariat (ATM Section)	Open	States have been asked to submit an implementation report for 2025 by 30th June 2026 . The States can submit their reports at any time, at least once annually. States can also submit an interim report, save it, and submit a full report at a later date. ICAO will present an annual analysis of implementation to APANPIRG.
.29-10	As only a few States/Administrations have submitted their information on the reporting tool, it was suggested that all remaining States/Administrations submit their information about 2024 so that the ICAO Secretariat can make further analysis of the ‘as-is’ status before the ATM SG/13 meeting planned in August 2025	CNS SG/30	APAC States/Administrations	Open	For the year 2024, only nine States had submitted a report. The reporting tool has been substantially modified for 2025. The older data is retained in the archive. However, States will not be able to submit or modify the older data for 2024.

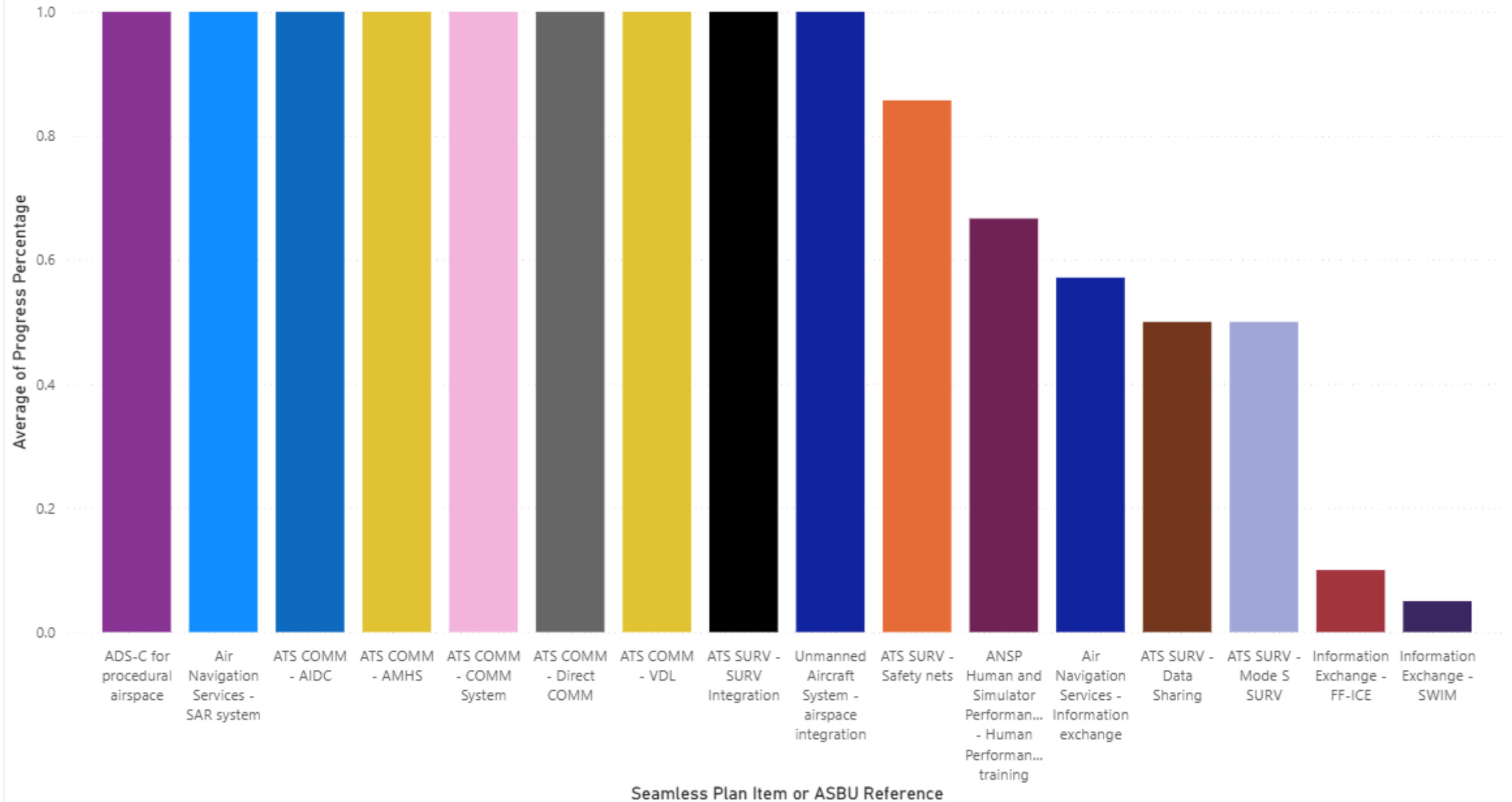
Count of State/Administration by Report Status



Average of Progress Percentage by Seamless Plan Item or ASBU Reference



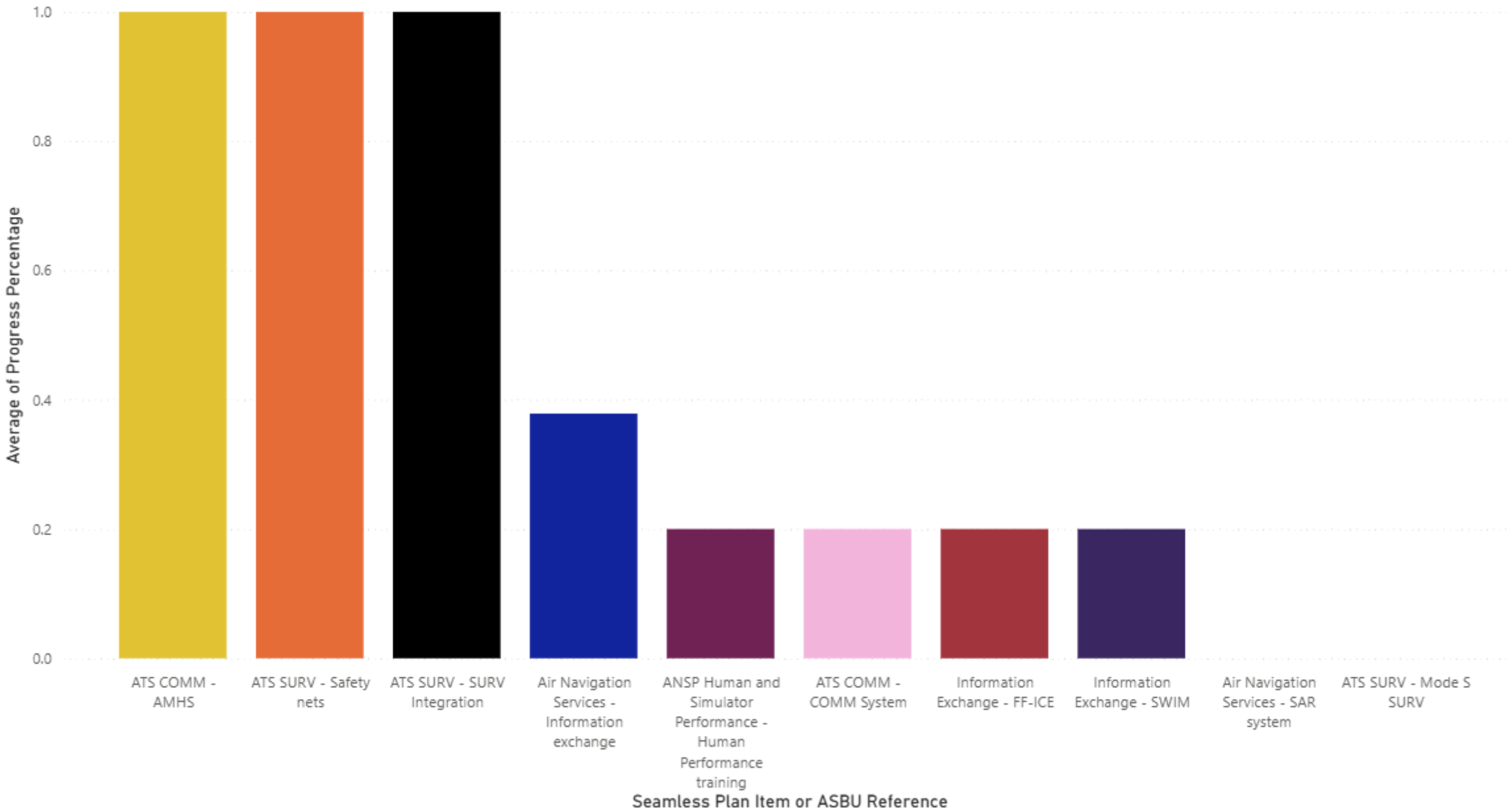

Average of Progress Percentage by Seamless Plan Item or ASBU Reference



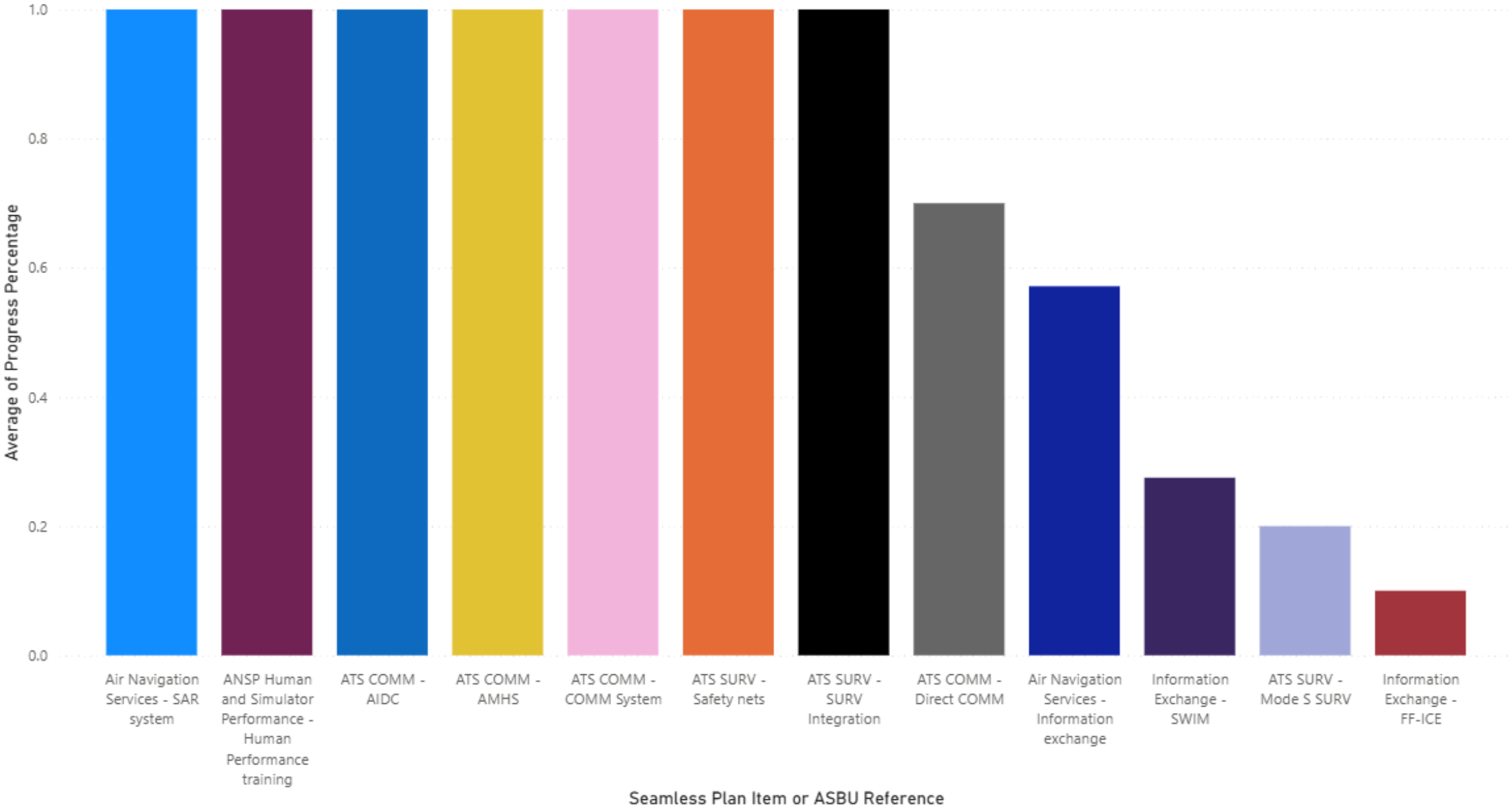
Bangladesh



Average of Progress Percentage by Seamless Plan Item or ASBU Reference



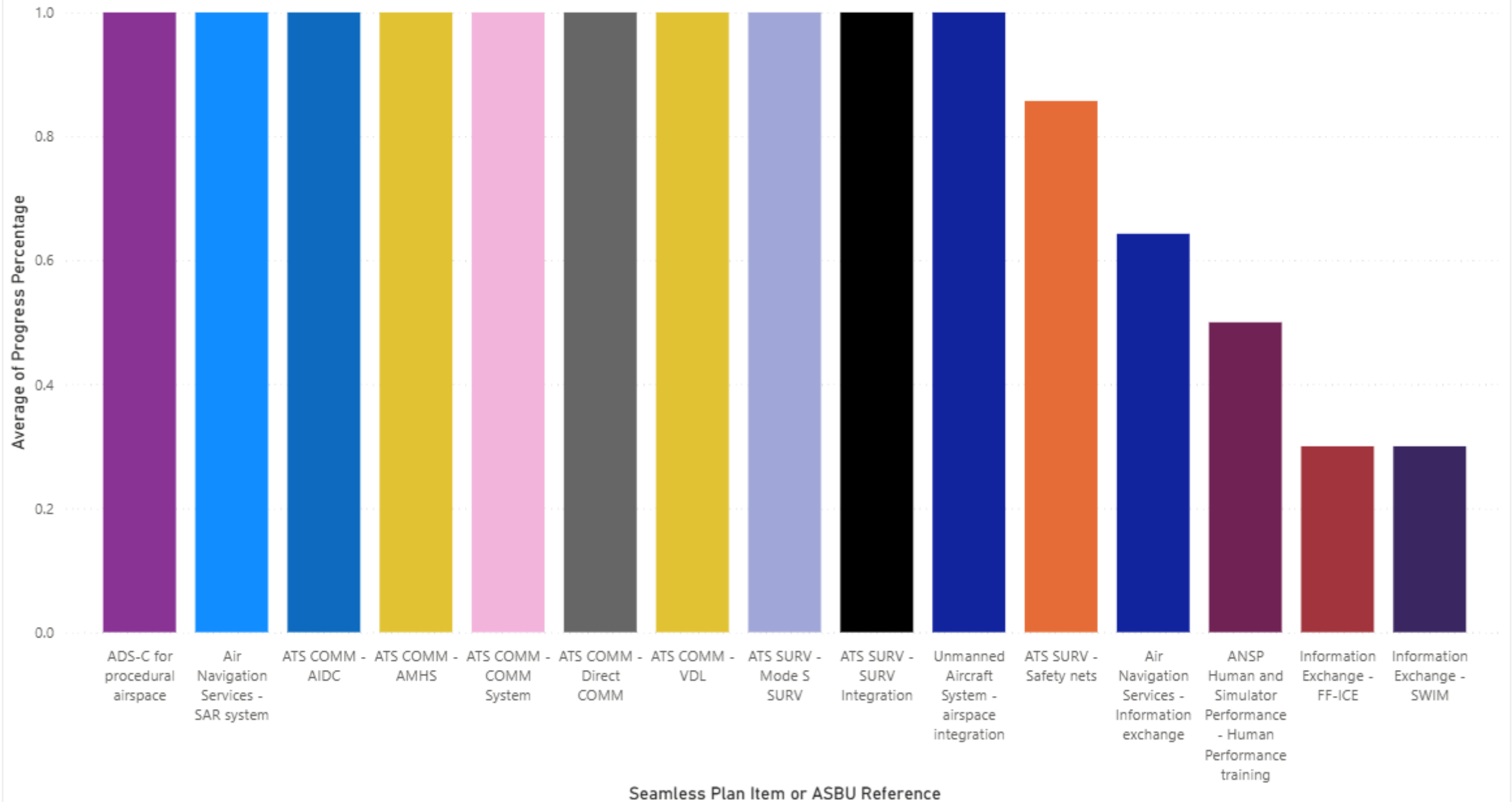

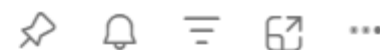
Average of Progress Percentage by Seamless Plan Item or ASBU Reference



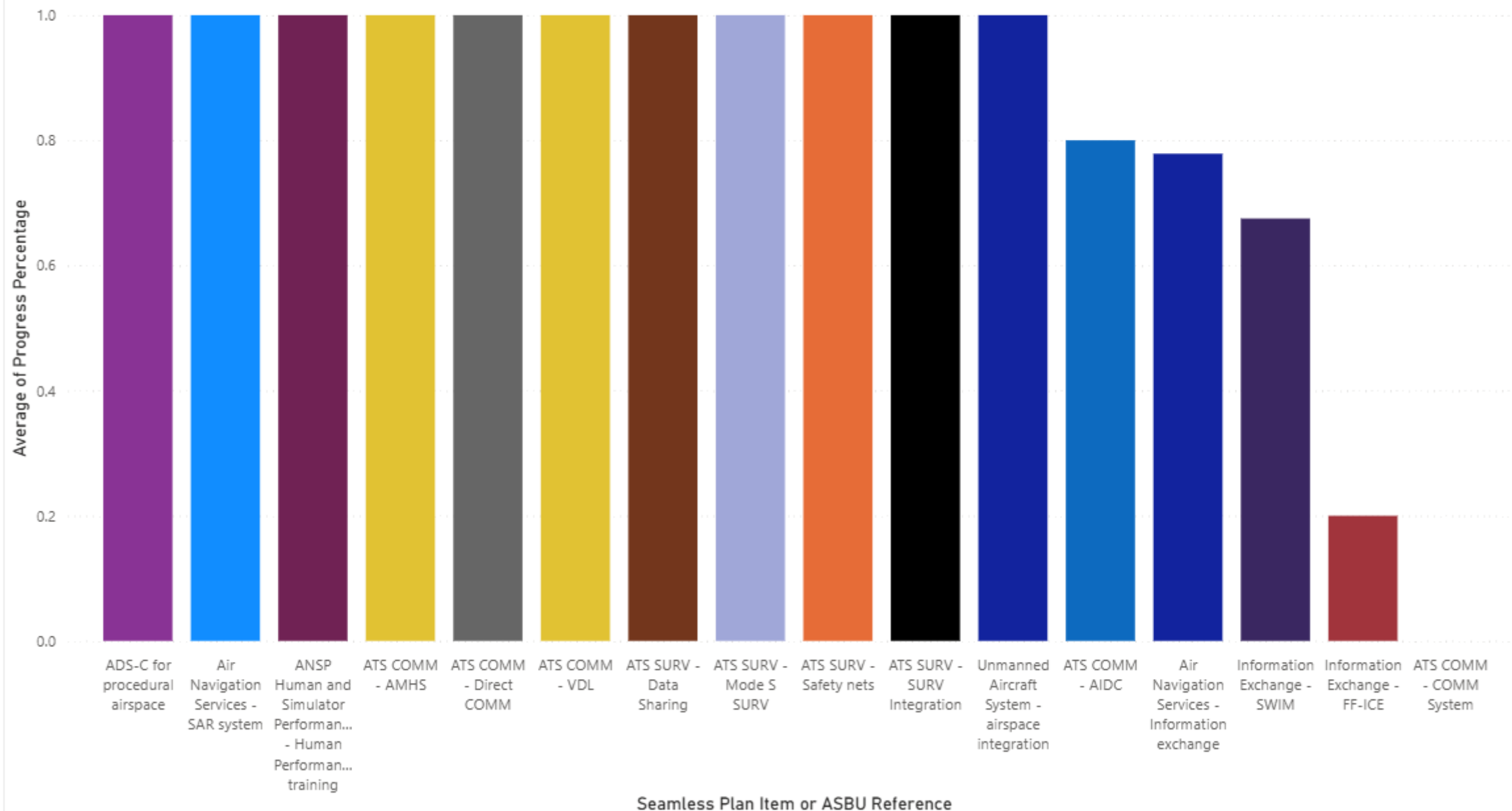
New Zealand
