





- Average 70 flights per day
- Average 55 flights overfly using P500 per day
- Average 15 domestic flights and international flights per day
- One overflight (except P500)
 - FL370
- Four international flights arriving and departing Kabul FIR at FL300 or above
 - Information shared with ACAA

- Agenda Item 1: Afghanistan SITREP update ICAO Summary
- Domestic/International flights observed
 - ADS-B data received by ICAO (1-5 December)
- Average remains largely unchanged
- Three overflight (except P500)
 - P173 at FL410 (twice)
 - B904 at FL370
- Three international flights arriving and departing Kabul FIR at FL300 or above
 - Information shared with ACAA





Kabul FIR Air Traffic Management Contingency Plan V2.1


