



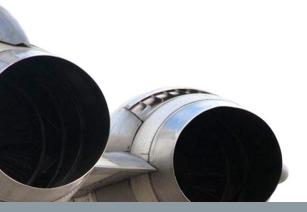
ICAO observation (11-14 January)

- 80 overflights (75-89) per day using P500
- Four overflight on N636 and M875
- One high altitude operation (FL300+)
- All other international flights were FL290-




