#### **SUMMARY**

With the aim of minimizing any probability of delay or security interference such as theft in the supply chain, when a controlled substance is in transport and a national law or international Convention prohibits disclosure of the technical name, this paper proposes the addition of a new special provision which would indicate to the cargo acceptance staff the reason why the technical name is not present.

**Action by the DGP:** The DGP-WG is invited to agree to the amendments proposed in the appendix to this working paper.

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Air transport of controlled substances is used to reduce the risk of security issues, such as theft, in the supply chain by enabling faster delivery.
- 1.2 There are presently two references found in the Technical Instructions indicating that the technical or chemical group names are not required, despite the presence of an asterisk in column 1 of the Dangerous Goods List, if a national law or international convention prohibits their disclosure if it is a controlled substance (3;1.2.7.1 and 5;4.1.5.5).

#### Part 3

#### 1.2.7 Generic or "not otherwise specified" (n.o.s.) names

1.2.7.1 Generic and "not otherwise specified" proper shipping names, indicated by the inclusion of an asterisk in column 1 of the Dangerous Goods List, must be supplemented with the technical or chemical group names unless a national law or international convention prohibits their disclosure if it is a controlled substance ...

### Part 5

#### 4.1.5.5 Infectious substances and controlled substances

The dangerous goods transport document must also include the name and telephone number of a responsible person when a national law or international convention prohibits the disclosure of the technical name following an "n.o.s.\*" entry or for infectious substances, UN 2814 and UN 2900.

- 1.3 The issue is that transport documents currently do not indicate these exemptions, which could lead to delays until it's confirmed that the substance is controlled.
- 1.4 One industry association, the International Air Transport Association (IATA), has a temporary Special Provision (A801) to indicate that a national law or international convention prohibits the disclosure of the technical name as it is a controlled substance.

"A801 A technical name is not needed for this entry if it is a controlled substance and a national law or international Convention prohibits its disclosure (see 4.1.2.1(d))."

## 2. **ACTION BY THE DGP**

- 2.1 The DGP-WG is invited to agree to the amendments proposed in the appendix to this working paper which:
  - a) add a new special provision to Table 3-2; and
  - b) assign the new special provision to UN 1544 Alkaloids, solid, n.o.s., UN 1544 Alkaloid salts, solid, n.o.s., UN 3140 Alkaloids, liquid, n.o.s. and UN 3140 Alkaloid salts, liquid, n.o.s.\* in column 7 of Table 3-1.

The technical or chemical group names are not required to be indicated on a dangerous goods transport document or on the package if a national law or international convention prohibits its disclosure if it is a controlled substance (see 3;1.2.7.1). The dangerous goods transport document must also include the name and telephone number of a responsible person when a national law or international convention prohibits the disclosure of the technical name (see 5;4.1.5.5).
