1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The U.S. Transportation Security Administration submitted the attached Information Paper to the 36th Meeting of the ICAO Aviation Security Panel (AVSECP/36), which took place from April 7-11, 2025, at ICAO Headquarters in Montreal, Canada.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 This Paper reviews the history and creation of the U.S. Transportation Security Administration's OSS Pilot Program, including the specific requirements for participation. Additionally, the Paper notes recent updates on the Pilot Program, including operationalization of the first OSS arrangement. The intent of sharing this information with the AFI SECFAL Plan Steering Committee so that other States and stakeholders may benefit from these experiences when developing and sustaining bilateral OSS arrangements.

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
