






Arab States's contribution to the implementation of CORSIA 2023

CORSIA Participating ACAO Member from 1 January 2023





Status of Implementation of CORSIA







- ✓ Lack to establish a national regulatory framework.
- ✓ Challenges relating to awareness and capacity building.
- ✓ Lack of technical and human resources.
- No financial independence, financial difficulties and low budget allocated to environment protection.
- ✓ multiples difficulties encountered by some Arab States to establish and develop their State Action Plan on CO₂ Emissions Reduction Activities for international aviation.
- CORSIA/MRV implementation challenges and regulatory framework.
- ✓ Lack of Quality Management System & Aviation Env. Dept.

- ✓ ACAO Act CORSIA Capacity Building
- ✓ Establish an ACAO Regional group on SAF.
- ✓ Organize the Second Arab Environment Forum (November 2023)
- ✓ Establish a pool of Instructors in environment
- ✓ Active contribution to COP 28
- ✓ Establish an ACAO working group for LTAG
