ECAC initiatives to support States addressing CO₂ emissions from international aviation

- State Action Plans:
 - The ECAC/EU Guidelines and common Section
 - Supports ECAC States to update and submit its SAP's to ICAO in accordance with ICAO Guidance material
 - Assistance provided to 12 States and 2 tailored workshops. 41 ECAC States have submitted Plans, 32 of which updated in the last revision cycle
 - To be updated by APERTG for the 2024 revisions
 - To incorporate new European actions and any updates in ICAO Guidance material





ECAC initiatives to support States addressing CO₂ emissions from international aviation

CORSIA:

- Two CORSIA workshops organised in 2022, in close cooperation with ICAO EURNAT office:
 - CORSIA IS/2 (9 March 2022) gathered 137 participants from 26 Member States , 10 industry stakeholders and 6 organisations
 - CORSIA IS/3 (15 June 2022) gathered 59 participants from 25 ECAC Member States
- Three tailored workshops (two virtual, one in person) provided to individual States.






- Sustainable Aviation Fuels (SAF):
 - First edition of the ECAC Guidance on Sustainable
 Aviation Fuels (SAF) > endorsed by ECAC Directors
 General on 24 February 2023
 - Developed by the SAF Task-Group > 29 experts from 13 ECAC
 States and 4 organisations, under the EAEG Expanded











- ✓ provide best practices and key policy recommendations.





The European SAF policy landscape



Section III: Key Policy Recommendations

To develop harmonised SAF policies

- ✓ Gather data and create national SAF strategies
- ✓ Set targets and create predictability to mobilise investments
- ✓ Develop national SAF roadmaps or transition pathways
- ✓ Establish a sustainability framework with credible emission reductions and build social trust
- ✓ Select the most suitable policy or combination of policy options



Identification of challenges and needs for harmonisation

What Comes Next?

- ✓ Capacity-Building and support to States
 - To be provided in cooperation with the ICAO EURNAT office to avoid any duplications
 - ➤ To be fully complementary to any additional support from ECAC States under ACT-SAF

- ✓ International discussion and cooperation with ICAO
 - Fundamental to facilitate global harmonization and reduce SAF barriers
 - ICAO regional seminars, Stocktaking and CAAF/3 offer a unique opportunity to address barriers
