Subject: Regional Seminars on Global Aviation Security Plan (GASeP) and Awareness on Risk Assessment Processes and on Doc 10084: *Risk Assessment Manual for Civil Aircraft Operations Over or Near Conflict Zones* (Cairo, Egypt, 15 – 19 June 2025)

Dear Sir/Madam,

I wish to invite you to participate in the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) MID Regional Seminars on Global Aviation Security Plan (GASeP), and Awareness on Risk Assessment Processes and on Doc 10084: *Risk Assessment Manual for Civil Aircraft Operations Over or Near Conflict Zones*. These Seminars are organized in cooperation with the Safer Skies Consultative Committee (SSCC) and hosted by MID Regional Office from 15 to 19 June 2025, in Cairo, Egypt.

The Regional Seminar on Global Aviation Security Plan (GASeP) is a multi-disciplinary event that will serve as a dynamic forum for exchanging ideas, experiences, and best practices among experts from States and other stakeholders, including from the industry. The aim is to reaffirm that the GASeP is a universal tool for each expert and allows take action, and bring about progressive improvements. The Seminar will include presentation and panel discussions aimed at fostering a creative exchange on the recently approved Second Edition of the GASeP, and to firmly placing it at the heart of every aviation security improvement efforts.

The Regional Awareness Seminar on Risk Assessment Processes and on Doc 10084: *Risk Assessment Manual for Civil Aircraft Operations Over or Near Conflict Zones* will provide the participants from States with an opportunity to share experience related to the development of effective inter-agency coordination processes in order to establish a common approach on security risk assessments, including the exchange of threat-related information among relevant national authorities, and effective exchange of threat and risk-related information at regional and international level.

Additionally, the agenda of the Seminar will consist of the following:

- an overview of past incidents related to conflict zones and lessons learned;
- a presentation of the Doc 10084 guidance and how it can be leveraged by aviation stakeholders;
- a discussion about current challenges;

- two table-top exercises; and
- a presentation of existing international and regional conflict zone risk management organizations.

The Seminar will allow the participants to actively engage in interactive sessions to build awareness on the guidance on conflict zone risk management, based on the recently updated Doc 10084.

After attending this Seminar, aviation stakeholders will have enhanced understanding of the risk to civil aircraft from operations over or near conflict zones and of the guidance outlined in Doc 10084 and how it can be leveraged to strengthen their respective conflict zone risk management practices.



As such, internal coordination within each State is required before the submission of the registration.
