**SADIS FOCAL POINTS**

**SUMMARY**

A list of SADIS operational focal points has been created and updated by the ICAO Secretariat in Montreal for many years. This list is now in need of an update.

**1. DISCUSSION**

1.1 A copy of the SADIS Focal Points is included as **Appendix A**. It is created and maintained by the ICAO Secretariat in Montreal and is reliant on people informing them of changes to the focal points.

1.2 The list mostly contains the national met services, or in some cases the ANSP for around 100 SADIS using states. There are some missing entries, some that can be removed entirely as they are no longer SADIS using States, some entries that are completely wrong and many of the records are out of date as people have changed jobs.

1.3 The meeting attendees are invited to review the entry for their State, and to let the SADIS manager know what you would like it changed to. Note: all fax numbers are going to be removed!

1.4 At present this document has been published on <https://www.icao.int/airnavigation/aeronautical-meteorological-service/documents> however it is felt that this should be moved to the ICAO Secure portal instead. Therefore once updates are made the SADIS manager will ask the ICAO Secretariat to relocate it.
