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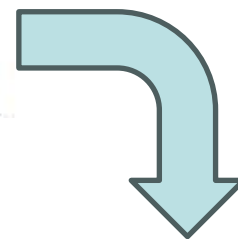
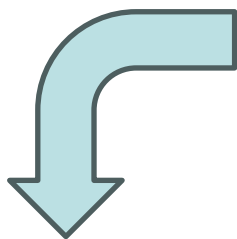

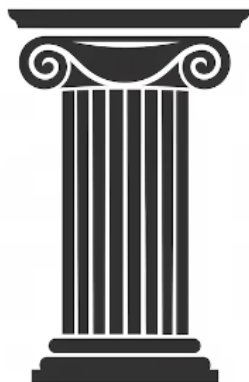

SRIS

Safety Recommendation Information System

Article 18 of Reg. EU 996/2010 requires all Member States to place in a central repository:

- All Safety Recommendations issued by the Member States.
- The responses received by the addressee relating to the Safety Recommendation.
- Any Safety Recommendation received from third countries.





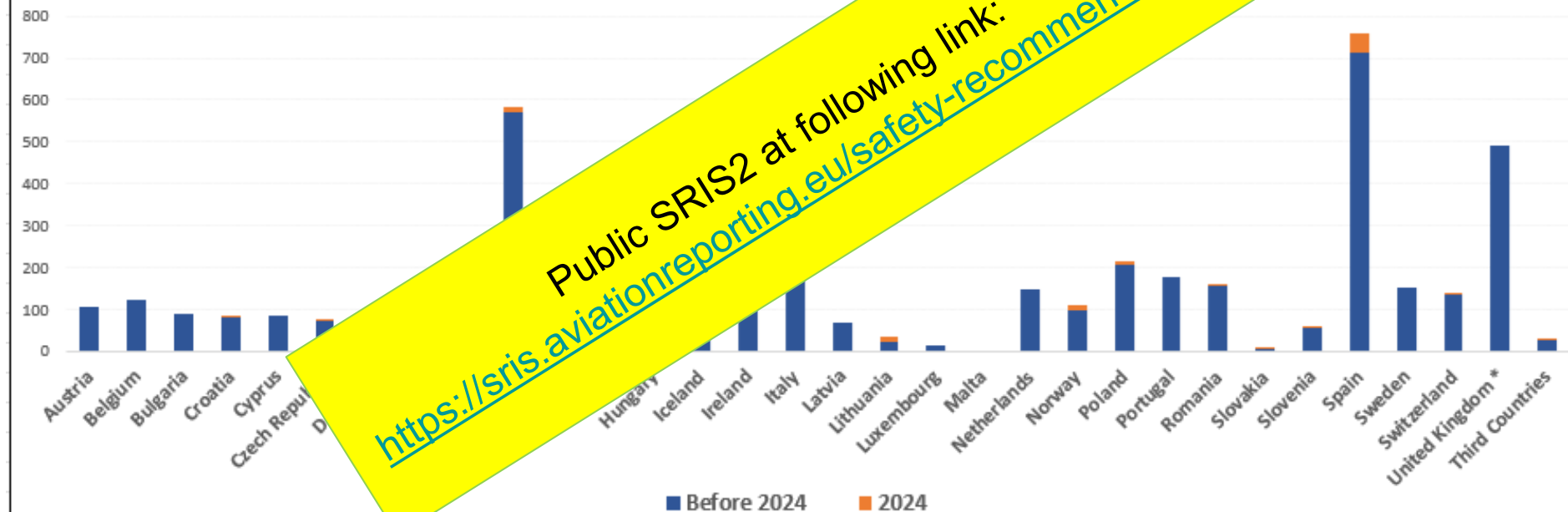
SRIS Safety Recommendations

* Due to Brexit, the UK safety recommendations that have been issued after 2020 are not included in the ECR-SRIS

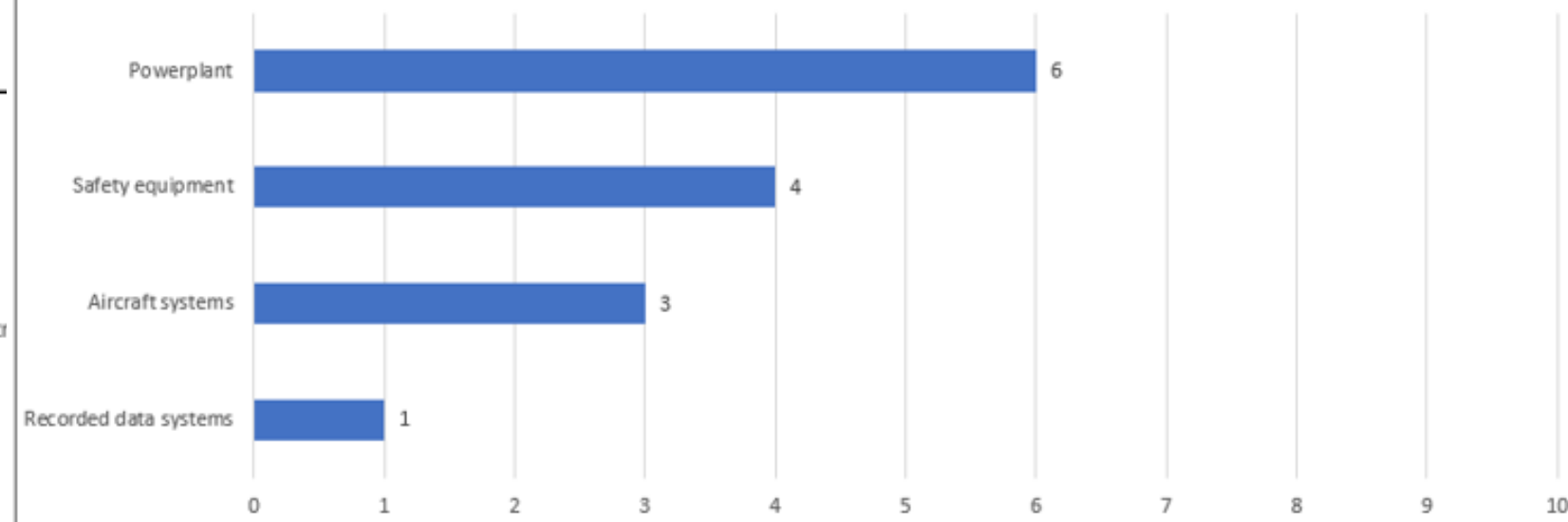

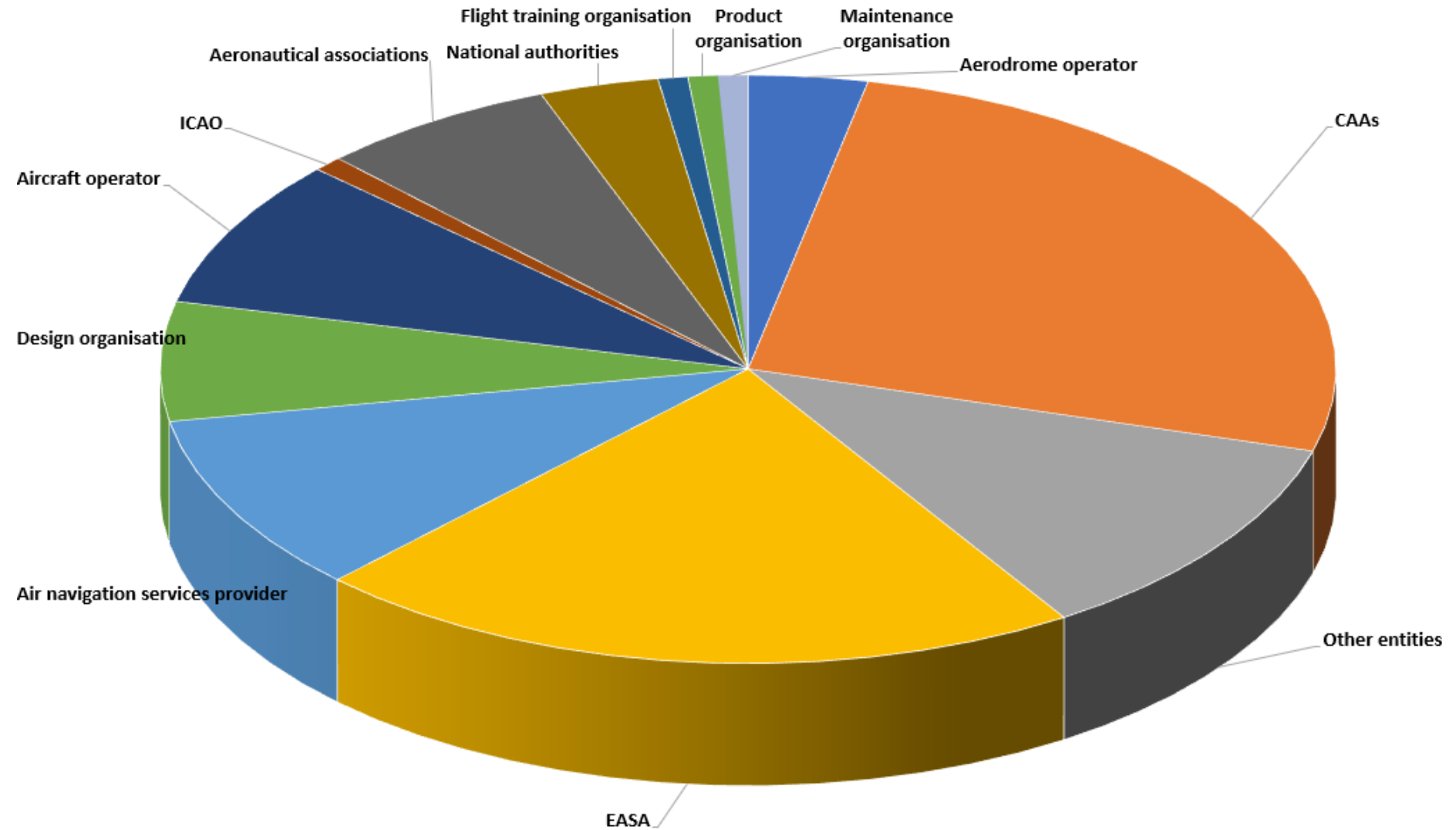

WG6 Guidelines

- Definition of a Safety Recommendation of Union Wide Relevance (SRUR).
- Guidance on closing Safety Recommendations that have not been responded to by an addressee over a period of time.
- Developing and Issuing Safety Recommendations.
- Guidance on assessing responses to Safety Recommendations to Article 18 of EU996/2010.
- Guidance on preparing response text for entry onto the Safety Recommendation Information System (SRIS) for public use.
- Letter of transmittal example.
- ENCASIA Safety Recommendation policy (TCSRs).
- A short ENCASIA WG6 note on collaboration between authorities on occurrence data, national databases and the European Central Repository.
- Flowchart for Safety Recommendations of Union Wide Relevance (SRUR).



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THE DIALOGUE WITH THE ADDRESSEE





The role of the addressee

- The addressee should be the most appropriate to take action to mitigate the safety issue upon which the recommendation is based.
- The addressee should have the authority to act.
- The addressee can provide valid solutions to solve/mitigate the safety issue addressed by the Safety Recommendation.
- The addressee can identify safety issues early in the investigation and have an opportunity to mitigate those issues before the issuance of a Safety Recommendation.



Workshops on Safety recommendations

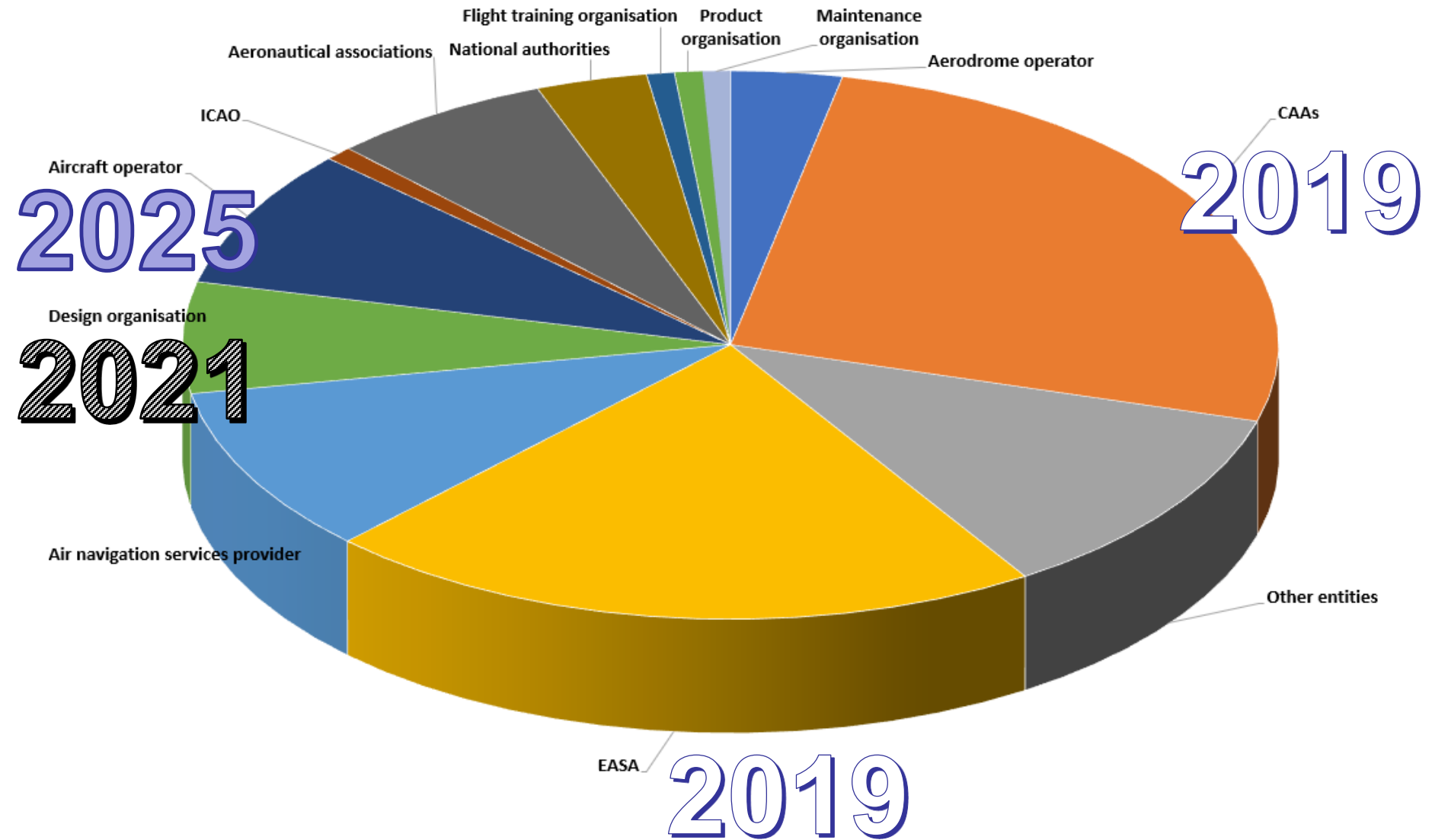
