About Angola

Angola is located on the southwest coast of Africa, bordered by the Atlantic Ocean, and positioned just south of the equator. Its landscape ranges from sunlit coastal plains and rich tropical forests to expansive savannas and elevated highlands, offering a captivating blend of natural beauty and geographical diversity.

Founded in 1575, Luanda is Angola's capital and its political, economic, and cultural center. The city has evolved into a regional hub for trade, services, and transportation. The province of Luanda comprises nine municipalities, including Talatona, where the Summit venue is located.



Culture

Luanda reflects a rich blend of African and Portuguese influences, expressed through music (notably Semba and Kizomba), art, and festivals.

Language

The official language in Luanda is Portuguese, widely used in formal settings, while national languages, such as Kimbundu, are commonly spoken in everyday life, influencing the local Portuguese dialect.

Gastronomy

Rooted in fresh, local ingredients, Angolan cuisine is rich in flavour and tradition, featuring beloved dishes such as Muamba de Ginguba (chicken in a savoury peanut sauce), Funge (a staple cassava accompaniment), Calulu (a hearty fish stew), and Mufete (a flavourful grilled fish dish). Together, these offer a delicious glimpse into Angola's vibrant cultural identity and the warmth of its culinary heritage.

PARTICIPATION AT THE SUMMIT

Participation at the Global Civil Aviation Gender Summit 2026 – *Advancing Aviation through the Empowerment of Women* is open to ICAO Member States, international and regional organizations,

industry stakeholders, and public/private sector representatives, including those from air transport services and regulation, as well as non-governmental organizations.

Governments, stakeholders, and entities invited by ICAO through State Letter 17/4.3-26/15, and by the Minister of Transport and the National Civil Aviation Authority (ANAC) of Angola, are encouraged to submit their responses by **July 4, 2026**, indicating, to the extent possible, the composition of their delegations.

REGISTRATION

Online registration for the Summit is open and available on the [event website](#). Participants must complete the registration prior to arrival but no later than **July 15, 2026**.

On-site credential collection will open one day before the Summit at the event venue.

Notice: *Access to the event venue and designated areas will be restricted to delegates with appropriate credentials. The same identification data used for registration must be provided for accreditation. Credentials are personal, non-transferable, and issued upon presentation of valid identification. Misuse of credentials may result in legal action.*

ENTRY FORMALITIES

Dr. António Agostinho Neto International Airport is the arrival airport for direct flights to Luanda, in Icolo e Bengo. The International Airport is located 40km from the city center.

Airport Reception:

Dedicated counters will assist participants with immigration, baggage handling, and onward transportation.

Entry and Visas:

A passport with at least 6 months of validity is required for all visitors to enter Angola.

Visa options include:

- Tourist Visa (~USD 70)
- Short-term Visa (~USD 80)

Visas may be obtained through [Angolan diplomatic missions or via the official online platform](#).

Forms should be duly completed, including a request addressed to the Immigration and Foreigners Service, duly justifying the reason for the request.

Complementary documents such as a valid passport and two photocopies, two identical passport-type photographs with a plain background (recent and in good condition) of the recipient, and proof of payment of the fee must be presented.

Many countries across Africa, Europe, Asia, Oceania, the Americas, and the Caribbean and Pacific are exempt from obtaining a visa for entry. Please consult the [Annex](#) for a full list of exempt countries.

TRANSPORT

Participants are requested to provide travel details in the registration form to ensure transport for delegates.

For non-delegate participants, transportation from the airport to hotels and the Summit venue can be arranged through the main transportation options available in Luanda, which include:

- Collective taxis, known as "**candongueiros**." These services are widely used by locals due to their affordable cost and extensive coverage throughout the city.
- Private taxis, such as [Lyu Brothers Company](#), [Rosalina Express](#) and taxi services via apps like YANGO, HEETCH, T-LEVA, and BOLT offer greater comfort and safety. **Please note, transportation via private taxi is recommended.*

Formal public transportation is provided by companies such as the Transporte Colectivo Urbano de Luanda (TCUL). Maritime transport in Luanda Bay is also available, which is used for specific routes. Rail transport through the Luanda Railway connects the capital to other regions of the country.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Participants are responsible for making hotel reservations directly and are welcome to indicate participation in the Summit to be able to benefit from discounted rates. All participants are strongly encouraged to book accommodation early due to limited room availability.

- A yellow fever vaccination certificate may be needed.
- Drinking tap water is not recommended; bottled water is preferred.

SECURITY

Luanda, the capital of Angola and the country's main economic hub, is a vibrant, dynamic, and welcoming city, fully prepared to host international delegations during the Summit.

Like major metropolitan cities around the world, Luanda faces urban challenges associated with population growth, mobility, and intense economic activity. Nevertheless, the city maintains an overall safe environment for residents and visitors, supported by strengthened prevention, monitoring, and response measures implemented by the competent authorities.

Commercial areas, markets, transport terminals, and high-traffic zones require normal security awareness, and visitors are advised to adopt basic preventive precautions, as would be recommended in any major international city.

To ensure a smooth and comfortable stay, the following is recommended:

- Avoid displaying valuable items openly in public places;
- Prefer travelling in groups during the night;
- Use formal transportation and services recommended by hotels or the event organisers;
- Choose well-lit routes and busier areas;
- Use ATMs and banking services located in secure places.

The Angolan authorities, particularly the National Police, have significantly reinforced urban security mechanisms, including:

- Continuous monitoring of main roads through the Integrated CCTV System;

- Regular patrols in strategic areas;
- Preventive and rapid-response operations in critical zones;
- Special security coordination throughout the Summit period.

Luanda is ready to welcome its visitors with hospitality, peace of mind, and a strong spirit of cooperation, providing a safe and positive experience throughout the duration of the Summit.
