



## ASSEMBLY — 39TH SESSION

### PLENARY

#### ACTION SHEET NO. 7

At its Seventh Plenary Meeting on 6 October 2016, the 39th Session of the Assembly adopted Resolutions:

- 15/1: Consolidated statement of ICAO policies on technical cooperation and technical assistance as presented in A39-WP/500
- 15/2: ICAO Programme for Aviation Volunteers as presented in A39-WP/500
- 16/2: Addressing cybersecurity in civil aviation as presented in A39-WP/493 Revision No. 1
- 28/1: *No Country Left Behind* (NCLB) Initiative as presented in A39-WP/501 Revision No. 1
- 28/2: Strategy on Disaster Risk Reduction and Response Mechanisms in Aviation as presented in A39-WP/501 Revision No. 1
- 22/1: Consolidated statement of continuing ICAO policies and practices related to environmental protection – Climate change as presented in A39-WP/461 (see also A39-WP/529)
- 22/2: Consolidated statement of continuing ICAO policies and practices related to environmental protection – Global market-based measure (MBM) scheme as presented in A39-WP/462, subject to: an editorial amendment to Preambular paragraph 14, whereby the term “new market mechanisms” is to be replaced with the term “new market mechanism”; the insertion of a new Operative paragraph 21 reading as follows:

“21. *Decides* that emissions units generated from mechanisms established under the UNFCCC and the Paris Agreement are eligible for use in CORSIA, provided that they align with decisions by the Council, with the technical contribution of CAEP, including on avoiding double counting and on eligible vintage and timeframe;”

and the consequent renumbering of existing Operative paragraphs 21 to 24 (see A39-WP/530 for the complete amended text of Resolution 22/2)

The reservations expressed by States with regard to Resolutions 22/1 and 22/2 will be recorded in the minutes of the Seventh Plenary Meeting and posted on the A39 website. They will also be reflected in the Provisional edition of A39 Resolutions and the consolidated edition of Assembly Resolutions in Force (as of 6 October 2016).
