ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE CANDIDATURES OF LATIN AMERICAN AND CARIBBEAN STATES FOR ELECTION TO THE COUNCIL OF ICAO (2017 – 2019)

(Presented by Guatemala, representing the Member States of the Latin American Civil Aviation Commission – LACAC²)

1. The countries and territories of Latin America and the Caribbean sponsoring this paper, in accordance with Article 50 of the Convention on International Civil Aviation, have the honour to present to the States participating in the 39th session of the ICAO Assembly the following candidates for election to the Council of the Organization for the 2017-2019 triennium:

- Group I: Brazil
- Group II: Argentina, Colombia and Mexico
- Group III: Cuba, Ecuador, Panama and Uruguay

2. Over time, the region has maintained close relations with ICAO, particularly through the Regional Offices in Lima and Mexico City, providing special support to the various tasks it is carrying out and cooperating actively in all matters relating to international civil aviation.

3. For all of these reasons, the sponsors of this working paper appreciate the support received from the international aviation community in electing our candidates.
