**FINAL REPORT OF THE CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE**

(Presented by the Chairperson of the Credentials Committee)

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The Final Report of the Credentials Committee indicates that credentials submitted by 182 Member States and 48 observers were found in due and proper form, and that 184 Member States and 55 observer delegations registered.

1. At the First Meeting of its Plenary held on 24 September 2019, the Assembly agreed to the establishment of the Credentials Committee and the Delegations of Chile, Fiji, Islamic Republic of Iran, Nigeria and Russian Federation were invited to nominate members for this Committee.

2. On 24 September 2019, the First Meeting of the Credentials Committee was held; the Committee was composed as follows:

Mr. Alberto Mena Padilla	(Chile)
Ms. Glenys Andrews	(Fiji)
Mr. Farhad Parvaresh	(Islamic Republic of Iran)
Mr. Emmanuel Dubem Chukwuma	(Nigeria)
Mr. Alexander Batalov	(Russian Federation)

The Committee unanimously elected Mr. Farhad Parvaresh, member of the delegation of the Islamic Republic of Iran, Chairperson of the Committee.

3. At the Second Meeting of the Plenary, the Chairperson of the Credentials Committee presented an interim report to the Assembly and informed that, as of 1500 hours on 24 September 2019, 173 Member States and 46 observer delegations had registered for the Assembly. Credentials in due and proper form had been received from 164 Member States and 43 observers.

4. The Assembly agreed on the recommendation of the Credentials Committee to urge all States and organizations that had not yet presented due and proper credentials to do so as soon as possible and, meanwhile, in view of Rule 7 of the Standing Rules of Procedure of the Assembly, to permit them to participate in its deliberations.

5. At its Fifth Meeting on 1 October 2019, the Credentials Committee found that the credentials submitted by 182 Member States and from 48 observers had been presented in due and proper form.
