ACTION ON SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

(Presented by Tunisia)

SUMMARY

This paper proposes that international aviation bodies and regional aviation organizations be included in the proposed amendment of Annex 13, paragraphs 6.10 and 6.11.

Action by the meeting is in paragraph 3.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Certain international aviation bodies and regional aviation organizations, such as, for example, EASA in Europe, can receive safety recommendations. Consequently, it would be advisable to take these bodies and organizations into account in paragraphs 6.10 and 6.11 of Annex 13 — *Aircraft Accident and Incident Investigation* discussion.

2. DISCUSSION

2.1 Paragraph 6.9 of Annex 13 states that safety recommendations can be addressed to ICAO.

2.2 Safety recommendations are often addressed to regional aviation organizations.

2.3 Annex 13, Standard 6.10 and proposed Recommendation 6.11 do not take into consideration the aforementioned bodies; they refer only to States.

3. ACTION PROPOSED

3.1 The meeting is invited to include in these new proposals all the organizations which safety recommendations concern.

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
