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Since 1970, Mr. Geoffrey Moshabesha held a number of technical and supervisory positions in the Lesotho Department of Civil Aviation. These ranged from Aeronautical Mobile Communications to Chief of Air Traffic Control. In June 1984, he became Deputy Director of Civil Aviation in Maseru, Lesotho for two years. In June 1986, he was promoted to Director of Civil Aviation and remained until February 1995. Mr. Moshabesha then went on to be an ICAO Regional Officer in the Air Transport ESAF Office in Nairobi, Kenya from March 1995 to August 1999. In September of that year, he became Chief of the Field Personnel Section in TCB at ICAO

Headquarters in Montreal, Canada. In May 2003, he became Chief of the Field Operations Section (Africa) in Montreal. From July to October 2006, Mr. Moshabesha was the ICAO Deputy Regional Director of the ESAF in Nairobi, Kenya. He is currently the Regional Director of this office.

Mr. Moshabesha received a Bachelor of Science in Aviation Administration at the Embry Riddle Aeronautical University in Daytona Beach, Florida in 1984 as well as an MBA in Aviation Administration at the Embry Riddle Aeronautical University in Miami, Florida in 1985.
