Mr. Amadou Ousmane Guitteye was born in Mali on 19 December, 1950. Mr. Guitteye has a very wide range of schooling beginning with two university degrees, each from the Dakar University in Senegal. His first degree was obtained in 1972 specializing in math and physics (MP I) and in 1973, another degree was obtained with specialization in math and physics (MPII). From 1974 to 1977, Mr. Guitteye acquired three separate Master of Science degrees. The first degree, obtained in 1974, was from the Dakar University in Senegal, with a specialization in Mathematics and the second specialization in Differential Geometry from the same University in 1976. In 1977, Mr. Guitteye's third Master's degree was obtained at the Paul Sabatier University in Toulouse, specializing in Probability and Statistics. Mr. Guitteye continued his studies from 1976 to 1978 and graduated from the Civil Aviation Training School (ENAC) in Toulouse with a Civil Aviation Engineering diploma. In 1978, he obtained his pilot license at the Muret-Lherm Aviation Training Center.

Mr. Guitteye is a member of the Association of Milan Experts in ASECNA and wrote a publication on Evolution and Perspectives for ATS and MET services in Africa.

In the beginning of Mr. Guitteye's professional career, he worked for ASECNA as a senior maintenance Officer. In 1981, he moved on to being airport manager and in 1987, he became the Senior Air Navigation Officer within ASECNA. Mr. Guitteye was a technical advisor to the Government of Mali from 1989 to 1990 and moved shortly thereafter to the Ministry of Transport & Tourism to become Director of the Civil Aeronautical Board. From 1992 to 1995, Mr. Guitteye was a technical advisor to the Government of Mali and in 1995 became Chief in the Maintenance Department back at ASECNA. From there, Mr. Guitteye became Chief of the R&D department, then Director of Survey & Strategic Planning, and then Director of Operations. He is currently the Regional Director for the ICAO Western and Central African (WACAF) Office.

Mr. Guitteye's is married and has a son and two daughters.
