Mr. Brian Day's career began as an air traffic controller (ATC) and progressed through various ATC and search and rescue (SAR) operational positions to roles in instructing and management, culminating as National SAR Manager with Airservices Australia and, later, as the aviation adviser on the project to consolidate Australian aeronautical and maritime SAR services into a joint Rescue Coordination Centre (RCC) in Canberra. .

Through the 1990s, Mr. Day was seconded as a field consultant on various ICAO ATC/SAR technical cooperation projects.

After early retirement from Airservices Australia, Mr. Day worked with the Australian aviation regulator (CASA) in developing regulations for the privatization of ATC.

In 2000, he started work with the ICAO Secretariat in Montreal as a Technical Officer (SAR) in the Air Traffic Management Section.

In 2007, he consulted to the UAE Air Force, assisting in the development of a joint RCC at the Bateen Air Base.

Presently, Mr. Day is contracted to the UAE General Civil Aviation Authority and continues, on a regular, part-time basis, to serve ICAO as its SAR consultant within the Secretariat and in conducting field projects for the Technical Cooperation Bureau (TCB). He has extensive field experience through Africa, Australasia, the Middle East, Europe and the Pacific. He holds a Diploma of Aviation in Air Traffic Services and a Graduate Diploma of Technology in Aviation Human Factors.
