Mr. Alexander ter Kuile was appointed Secretary General of the Civil Air Navigation Services Organisation in January 2001.

CANSO represents the interests of the world's Air Navigation Service Providers. CANSO Members control over 80% of global air traffic and serve over 70% of world airspace. In recent years CANSO has grown to become the global voice for Air Traffic Management.

Before joining CANSO, Mr. ter Kuile was a Director at Simat Helliessen & Eichner, the New York based air

transport consultant. He started his aviation career with KLM Royal Dutch Airlines in their Flight Operations department. In 1985 he joined the Marketing & Sales team of aircraft manufacturer Fokker Aircraft. In 1996 he transferred to aviation consultancy joining the European office of the RAND Corporation, where he specialised in airline networks and the competitive forces among airline alliances.

Mr. ter Kuile is a Board Member of the Air Transport Action Group and a Governor of the Flight Safety Foundation.
