**Chief Military Aviation Regulation, Defence
Swiss Air Force/Switzerland**



Colonel GS Ian Logan is the Chief of the Military Aviation regulation of the Swiss Air Force for the Department of Defense.

He has a fighter pilot background, flying the F-5E (Tiger), the Mirage III and the F/A18 (Hornet) combat aircraft. He graduated as General Staff Officer and became Squadron Commander in 1999. He was involved in different air shows organization, the last one being PAYERNE AIR 04 in 2004 as a Director.

In 2007 Ian obtained an Executive MBA at the University of Geneva in Management of International Affairs

He is currently the military representative of Switzerland in the Single Sky Committee of EU, in the NATO Air Traffic Management Committee, in the Provisional Council of EUROCONTROL and in the FABEC project. In 2006-2007, he was Chairman of the Civil Military Interface Standing Committee of EUROCONTROL.

In his actual function, he is also responsible for the organization of the airspace security during special events as the G8 summit in Evian in 2003, the World Economic Forum and the EURO foot 2008 championship in Switzerland last year.
