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Mr. Vince Galotti is the Deputy Director of the Air Navigation Bureau here at ICAO. Prior to this, he was the Chief of Air Traffic Management. Prior to his posting in Montreal, he worked for ICAO in its Paris Office as a Technical Officer. He also worked as an air traffic controller and ATS instructor in Saudi Arabia for a period of six years. After his time in Saudi Arabia, he attended Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University in Daytona Beach Florida where he earned a Master's Degree in Aeronautical Science. He also

taught at the University as an Adjunct Instructor and worked as a Research Assistant.

Mr. Galotti began his aviation career as an air traffic controller working for the Federal Aviation Administration in the New York Air Route Traffic Control Center. He has written extensively on aviation issues including a textbook on the Future Air Navigation System, published by Ashgate in 1997. He has recently contracted to write a second book which is tentatively entitled: "Global ATM, beyond FANS".
