Col. Hugo Jackson was born in Montevideo Uruguay on May 7, 1960. After completing high school, he joined the Uruguayan Air Force as a Cadet in 1977 and graduated in 1980 as AF Officer and Pilot. After undergraduate pilot training, Col. Jackson entered in the Air Force Fighter Sqn. As a fighter Pilot and an instructor, he completed 1000 hrs. In 1990, col. Jackson was appointed to the Air Force Academy when he flew 1000 hrs. as IP for screening and advanced training. In 1997 he graduated from the STAFF course and at the rank of Major went to the AF Academy as Chief Academics.

Over the years, Col. Jackson attended courses and seminars on subjects such as Safety Officer, Instructor Pilot and Academics, Peace Keeping Operations Officer, Laws at War (USM Cherry Point NAS) STAFF

officer, Safety Management System (ICAO SMS), Defence Intelligence Fellows Programme (DIA, Wash. DC), Military Cooperation in Disaster Ops. (DIILS Institute).

In 2001 at the rank of Lt.Col., Jackson become 2nd in command of the 2nd Air Force Base, and in 2003 and 2004 was appointed as assistant to the Uruguayan President at the Military Presidential Staff.

In 2005 as a Colonel, he serviced as Air Operations Director, in charge of the AOC. Today he is the director of the ATS, AFTN Operations Division and AIS. His flying hours include 2500 Fighters, Trainers, and twins transport missions.

Col. Jackson is married to Cinthya and they have two daughters Elisa and Michelle.
