Mr. Herbert Schramm is the Coordinator of International Affairs in the Federal Supervisory Authority for Air Traffic Services, BAF, in Germany. Before that, he was Director of Corporate Military Affairs of the German Air Navigation Service Provider, the DFS.

Prior to his assignment to the BAF and DFS he fulfilled various tasks in the military and international ATM environment. He holds the full colonel's rank of the Luftwaffe.

As the coordinator of International Affairs of the BAF and previously as the top military representative in the DFS, Mr. Schramm had to have a fundamental military Air Traffic

Management career. Prior to these posts, Mr. Schramm was working at European Organisation for the Safety of Air Navigation (EUROCONTROL) and as the top military ATM representative in the German Air Force Staff.

Previous roles included various military ATM headquarters' tasks being responsible for rules and regulation, training and licensing and plans and policy.

He looks back to around 15 years experience as an active military controller in Tower, Radar Approach and Area Radar and to a similar time span in ATM managerial tasks.
