Ramon Borges Cardoso graduated as a pilot at the Brazilian Air Force Academy in 1971. He is specialized in aerial refuelling operations, with an experience of 7.000 hours of flight, mostly in the KC-130 and KC-137 aircraft.

He started working in air space control in 1985, as Chief of Operations of the Control and Communications Group, a military organization responsible for supporting Brazilian Air Force operations. He has been instructor of

communications, radars and electronic warfare for the Brazilian Air Force Command and General Staff School.

Lt. Brig. Cardoso was Commander of the CINDACTA 2, an organization responsible for Airspace Defense and Air Traffic Control of the Brazilian south region, and was President of the Implementation Commission for the Amazon Surveillance System. He has been Chief of Cabinet of the Air Force Commander and, since March 2007, he is the Director of the Airspace Control Department.
