Mr. Tshepo Peege's career in aviation began when he attended the Aviation Maintenance Training School in Ethiopia. He then went on to Aeronautical Engineering at Aer Lingus in Dublin, Ireland and, finally, obtained a Masters Degree in Transport Policy and Management at the University of North London, United Kingdom.

Mr. Peege's professional qualifications include the Harvard Business School (Finance for Senior executives), Airline Management Integration at International Air Transport Association (IATA), Montreal and Integrated Safety Management System at the Singapore Aviation Academy. He also has a vast knowledge in Aircraft Accident Investigation, due to his diploma obtained at the University of Southern California, United States. Mr. Peege attended the Civil Aviation Chief Executive Program at the Singapore Civil Aviation Authority in Singapore, and obtained a Boeing 727 Flight Engineer License from the Ethiopian Civil Aviation Authority.

Mr. Peege has flown over 4000hrs throughout his professional career. He has been Flight Safety Manager as well as Technical Safety Investigator at South African Airways. He was the Chief Executive Officer at the Gateway International Airport in

Polokwane, South Africa as well as the Chief Director in the Aviation and Maritime Regulation: National Department of Transport. Mr. Peege went on to become Vice President of Corporate Safety, Security and Environment at South African Airways and has been a Representative of South Africa to the Council of ICAO since 2003. He was the President of the African Civil-Aviation Commission (AFCAC) from 2004 to 2007 and is the founding member and former Secretary General of the African Airlines Safety Council (AFRASCO).

From 2004 to 2005, Mr. Peege was the Second Vice President on the Council of ICAO and from 2009 to 2009 he was the First Vice President. On top of being a member of the International Panel of Aviation Experts of Singapore Civil Aviation Academy, Mr. Peege is also a member of several ICAO committees such as the Air Transport Committee, the Unlawful Interference Committee, the Technical Cooperation Committee, the Joint Support Committee, the Finance Committee, the Human Resources Committee and the Working Group on Efficiency. He has received several awards including the Aviation and Allied Business Conference award for Outstanding Leadership and service to the Aviation Industry in Africa.
