FLIGHT AND FLOW – INFORMATION FOR A COLLABORATIVE ENVIRONMENT (FF-ICE) CONCEPT

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The Global Air Traffic Management Operational Concept envisages an integrated, harmonized and globally interoperable system for all users in all phases of flight. As one component of this system, flight and flow – information for a collaborative environment (FF-ICE) addresses the many limitations in the current flight planning, flow management, trajectory management and information sharing processes.

1.2 AN-Conf/12-WP/8 urges States and industry to work through ICAO to mature the FF-ICE concept taking into account the guidance material on the FF-ICE concept in the *Manual on Flight and Flow – Information for a Collaborative Environment* (Doc 9965).
