GLOBAL NAVIGATION SATELLITE SYSTEM (GNSS) MANUAL

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The primary purpose of the *Global Navigation Satellite System (GNSS) Manual* (Doc 9849) is provide information on the implementation aspects of GNSS in order to assist States in the introduction of GNSS operations. It is intended to be used in conjunction with the relevant provisions in Annex 10 — *Aeronautical Telecommunications, Volume I — Radio Navigation Aids*. Doc 9849 is one of the reference documents for AN-Conf/12-WPs 21 and 22.

1.2 The first edition of Doc 9849 was published in 2005. A new edition has been drafted by the Secretariat with the assistance of the Navigation Systems Panel (NSP), and is currently being prepared for publication. The latest draft of the new edition will be posted as a reference document on the AN-Conf/12 website at www.icao.int/anconf12 prior to the Conference.
