1. VENUE OF THE MEETING

- 1.1 The ICAO Air Law Treaty Workshop will take place on 25–27 February 2026 at Hyatt Regency Hotel, located in the Dar es Salaam city centre. Dar es Salaam is the commercial city of Tanzania.
- 1.2 The nearest International Airport to the meeting venue is the Julius Nyerere International Airport, located about 09 kilometers to the city centre.
- 1.3 An optional Social Day will take place on February 27, 2026. It will involve a half-day tour of Mikumi National Park. Pickup from hotels will be at 04:00 and the return is scheduled for 21:00.

2. LANGUAGE AND DOCUMENTATION

- 2.1 The Workshop will be conducted in-person and in English language
- 2.2 The Workshop will be paperless, and all related documentation will be made available online through the following link: <https://www.icao.int/events/2026-icao-air-law-treaty-workshop-tanzania-third-edition>
- 2.3 All participants are informed to bring their devices to access meeting documentation.



3. VISA FORMALITIES

- 3.1 There are two options to obtain Tanzania Visa. These are Online Visa Platform and On-Arrival Visa Platform. However, it is recommended to use online Visa platform.
- 3.2 Participants are advised to ascertain at the respective Embassies or online whether they are exempt from the Tanzanian entry visa requirement.

- 3.3 Applicants for Online Visa are strongly advised to use the official Tanzania Immigration website at www.immigration.go.tz ONLY. Applications through third-party websites are not recommended.
- 3.4 Registered participants who wish to be assisted in obtaining their visa on arrival are requested to urgently forward their flight itinerary and copies of their passports to Mr. Douglas Bushiri at the following email address douglas.bushiri2@tcaa.go.tz with copies to dossa.luhindi@tcaa.go.tz, and aopolot@icao.int no later than 15 February 2026



4. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

- 4.1 Yellow fever vaccination is mandatory for travelers arriving from yellow fever endemic countries. More information can be obtained from the Ministry of Health website: [Yellow Fever Entry Requirements in Tanzania Mainland](#)



5. ACCOMMODATION

- 5.1 Participants should make their own hotel reservations and indicate that they are attending the ICAO Air Law Treaty Workshop in order to benefit from the special accommodation rates.
- 5.2 A list of recommended hotels is attached at the end of this bulletin.
- 5.3 Participants are encouraged to stay at the recommended hotels to facilitate transportation. Those staying at other hotels will be responsible for arranging their own transportation to and from the venue.



6. TRANSPORT

- 6.1 Participants will be provided with transportation for pick-up and drop-off between Julius Nyerere International Airport and the recommended hotels upon arrival and departure
- 6.2 A welcome desk will be available at the airport to provide necessary assistance.
- 6.3 Participants will be provided with transport from the recommended hotels to the meeting venue for the duration of the Workshop. Transport will also be provided to and from social events.

7. INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

- 7.1 The following Tanzanian mobile telecommunication service providers are available: AIRTEL, VODACOM, TTCL, YAS, HALOTEL, ZANTEL
- 7.2 Mobile telephone service providers also provide a gateway to the internet using GPRS, 3G, and 4G. Cell phone SIM cards are widely available; however, every SIM card user/buyer in the United Republic of Tanzania is expected by law to be registered for activation. The SIM card can be registered at the point of purchase.
- 7.3 The Internet will be free at the venue.



8. MEDICAL SERVICES

- 8.1 Participants will cover the cost of any medical treatment received. For advanced care, the following hospitals are recommended:

9. CURRENCY

- 9.1 The currency unit is the Tanzanian Shillings (TSHS).
- 9.2 Exchange rates are subject to fluctuation. Currently, 1 USD is approximately equivalent to 2446 TSHS.
- 9.3 Participants carrying USD 10,000 or more, or its equivalent in other currencies or negotiable instruments, are required to declare it at the designated customs desks at entry and exit points.



10. TIME

- 10.1 The time in Tanzania is GMT+3.





11. BANKING SERVICES

- 11.1 Banking hours are from 08:00 to 16:30 on weekdays and from 08:00 to 12:00 on Saturdays.



12. PLASTIC BAGS

- 12.1 Plastic bags, including those from duty-free shops, are prohibited upon entry. Travelers should use alternative eco-friendly bags.



13. ELECTRICITY SUPPLY

- 13.1 Tanzania uses the British system's standard three-pin sockets. The domestic power voltage is 240 volts. Participants are encouraged to ensure compatibility with their gadgets or to have international power adapters
