Yesterday's meeting, Sunday, 29 September 2019

Fifth Meeting of the Executive Committee

At its Fifth Meeting, held on Sunday, 29 September 2019 at 0900 hours, the Executive Committee considered Agenda Item 15 (Environment protection – General provisions, aircraft noise and local air quality – Policy and standardization), on the basis of two papers presented by the Council (WPs/54 and /57) and related papers. It agreed to recommend to the Plenary for adoption the revised Consolidated statement of continuing ICAO policies and practices related to environmental protection – General provisions, noise and local air quality proposed by the Council in WP/57, as amended during the discussion.

The Secretary General then informed the Executive Committee of ICAO's attendance to the UN Climate Action Summit convened in New York on 23 September 2019. She explained that ICAO had highlighted the decisions and important achievements in addressing international aviation CO₂ emissions, and the importance of partnerships among ICAO Member States, the aviation industry and other stakeholders to accelerate progress in implementing the ICAO basket of market-based measures, as a global coalition for sustainable aviation.

The Executive Committee then commenced consideration of Agenda Item 16 (Environmental protection – International aviation and climate change – Policy and standardization), which was documented in WPs/55 and /58 presented by the Council and related papers. While there was support for the revised Consolidated statement of continuing ICAO policies and practices related to environmental protection – Climate change as presented in WP/58, it was agreed that the Chairperson, the President of the Council and the Secretariat would consult with States and that the Committee would return to this item at a later meeting.

Sixth Meeting of the Executive Committee

At its Sixth Meeting, held on Sunday, 29 September 2019 at 1415 hours, the Executive Committee considered Agenda Item 17 (Environment protection – Carbon offsetting and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation (CORSIA)) on the basis of WPs/56 and /59 presented by the Council and related papers. The overwhelming majority of States were in support of the proposed revised Consolidated statement on CORSIA as presented in WP/59, which would be forwarded to the Plenary for adoption.

The Executive Committee then returned to Agenda Item 16 (Environmental protection – International aviation and climate change – Policy and standardization), with the President of the Council reporting on the outcome of the consultations by him, the Chairperson and the Secretariat with States regarding the revised Consolidated statement of continuing ICAO policies and practices related to environmental protection – Climate change presented by the Council in WP/58. The President of the Council proposed that the revised Consolidated statement be accepted in the form presented. The overwhelming majority of States were in agreement. It was noted, however, that, if necessary, the Committee could return to this item again, after Delegates had reviewed the changes proposed thereto by China, India and the Russian Federation which were posted on the A40 website at:

The Executive Committee thereafter considered the seven Sections of Agenda Item 14 (Facilitation Programmes), which were documented in WPs/6, /8, /5, /60, and /61 and IP/7 presented by the Council and related papers. Due to the lack of time, not all Delegations could present their inputs and comments. Consequently, the Committee agreed that any additional comments and inputs should be e-mailed to the Secretariat at fa1@icao.int, by noon on Monday, 30 September 2019, at the latest.
