Yesterday's meetings, Monday, 30 September 2019

Seventh Meeting of the Executive Committee

At its Seventh Meeting, held on Monday, 30 September 2019, at 0900 hours, the Executive Committee considered all three Sections of Agenda Item 25 (ICAO Civil Aviation Training and Capacity Building) on the basis of WP/64 presented by the Council and related papers.

The Executive Committee next considered the first Section of Agenda Item 19 (Increasing the efficiency and effectiveness of ICAO) based on WP/48 presented by the Council and a related paper, as well as an oral report on the examination of the current structure of the ICAO Secretariat. In light of time constraints, it was agreed to continue discussion of this Agenda Item at the next meeting.

Fourth Meeting of the Technical Commission

At its fourth meeting on Monday, 30 September 2019, at 0900 hours, the Technical Commission resumed and completed its work on Agenda Item 30 (Other issues to be considered by the Technical Commission), working paper groups 4, 5, 6 and 7.

At its next meeting, the Technical Commission will begin reviewing the report materials on Agenda Item 27 (Annual Reports of the Council to the Assembly for 2016, 2017 and 2018), Agenda Item 28 (Aviation Safety and Air Navigation Policy), Agenda Item 29 (Aviation Safety and Air Navigation Regional Implementation Coordination Mechanisms) and Agenda Item 30.

Second Meeting of the Administrative Commission

The Administrative Commission held its second and final meeting on Monday, 30 September 2019, at 0900 hours with Mr. Mark Rodmell (United Kingdom) as its Chairperson.

Agenda Items 41, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52 and 42 were considered.

The Chairperson presented a draft report highlighting the discussions held and the recommendations made, as reflected in the report.

The Commission recommended that the Draft Report, with some minor amendments, be referred to the Plenary for approval of the Reports and adoption of the Draft Assembly Resolutions.

In closing the meeting the Chairperson thanked the Commission and Secretariat staff for their contributions and commended the efficient and effective proceedings which have helped the Commission accomplish its work.

The meeting adjourned at 1010 hours.

Eighth Meeting of the Executive Committee

At its Eighth Meeting, held on Monday, 30 September 2019, at 1430 hours, the Executive Committee resumed and completed consideration of the two Sections of Agenda Item 19 (Increasing the efficiency and effectiveness of ICAO) based on WP/48 presented by the Council and related papers, as well as an oral report on the examination of the current structure of the ICAO Secretariat.

The Executive Committee next considered the two Sections of Agenda Item 23 (Technical Assistance Programme) on the basis of WPs/4 and /63 presented by the Council and related papers. It agreed to recommend to the Plenary for adoption the revised Assembly Resolution on the Comprehensive Regional Implementation Plan for Aviation Security and Facilitation in Africa as set forth in WP/63.

Following consideration of Agenda Item 24, the Executive Committee agreed to recommend to the Plenary for adoption the revised Consolidated statement of ICAO policies on technical cooperation and technical assistance proposed by the Council in WP/66.

The Executive Committee then commenced consideration of Agenda Item 26 (Other high-level policy issues to be considered by the Executive Committee). It completed consideration of the first Section and agreed to recommend to the Plenary for adoption the new Assembly Resolution on Commercial space transport (CST) proposed by the Council in WP/15, as amended during the discussion. The Committee then commenced consideration of the second Section on innovation on the basis of WP/14 presented by the Council and related papers. In light of time constraints, it was agreed to resume consideration of that Section and the remaining Sections at the Committee's next meeting.

The Chairperson recalled that, at its Fourth Meeting (EX/4), the Committee had agreed to return to the revised Consolidated statement on continuing ICAO policies related to aviation security proposed by the Council in WP/27 at a later meeting, based on a report by the small drafting group which had been established to review the proposal set forth in WP/528 Revision No. 1 to amend the Declaration on Aviation Security contained in the said Consolidated statement. He highlighted that the Declaration on Aviation Security had been posted on 29 September 2019 on the A40 website under *Reference Documents* at:

Delegations were invited to provide comments and inputs by e-mail to the Secretariat at asf@icao.int, by close of business, Monday, 30 September 2019, at the latest. The comments and inputs would be taken into consideration during the Ninth Meeting of the Executive Committee to be held on Tuesday, 1 October 2019, at 0900 hours.

Third Meeting of the Legal Commission

The Legal Commission held its third and last meeting on Monday, 30 September 2019, at 1400 hours. It considered and agreed with amendments, the draft report contained in A40-WP/601, A40-WP/597 and A40-WP/600, and decided to submit it to the Plenary, for approval.

Third Meeting of the Economic Commission

The Economic Commission, at its third meeting on Monday, 30 September 2019 approved WP/579 containing text of its draft report on the General Section and Agenda Items 31 and 32, as well as WP/580 and WP/602 containing text of draft reports relating to Agenda Items 33 and 34 respectively, as amended by the Commission. The draft report relating to Agenda Item 35, presented in WP/610, was also reviewed and the Commission approved the Consolidated statement of continuing ICAO policies in the air transport field, subject to amendment. The Commission also agreed to revise WP/611 containing text of its draft report on Agenda Item 36. The Commission recommended that the above-mentioned draft reports be referred to the Plenary for adoption.
