Island Highlights Tour

This curated Nassau tour offers a concise overview of the island's history, culture, and key landmarks.

The experience includes a drive through Parliament Square and a brief stop at the Bahamas Rum Cake Factory. Guests will continue to Atlantis Paradise Island for a photo opportunity at the Royal Towers, followed by a pass-through Potters Cay Dock to observe local commerce and maritime activity.

The route proceeds along Shirley Street, highlighting historic churches and civic institutions, with a featured stop at Fort Fincastle and the Queen's Staircase. Additional points of interest include the Nassau Public Library, Central Bank of The Bahamas, and Gregory's Arch.

The tour also passes through the Graycliff Hotel area, featuring its chocolate factory, art gallery, and the Junkanoo Museum, as well as Fort Charlotte.

A scheduled stop at Twin Brothers includes a light lunch and conch salad demonstration, concluding with a brief visit to Junkanoo Beach before return.
