VISA REQUIREMENTS

Passport holders from the following States do not require a visa to enter Mongolia for stays within the period permitted under bilateral or unilateral arrangement

VISA REQUIREMENTS

Holders of Diplomatic and Official/Special Passports from Asia-Pacific countries that have established visa exemption agreements with Mongolia are permitted to enter Mongolia without a visa

Passport holders from countries not included in the above-mentioned list are required to obtain a visa prior to entering Mongolia. Participants from these countries are advised to contact the Forum Secretariat directly at nomin@mfa.gov.mn to ensure the smooth processing of visa applications and related arrangements.

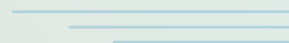

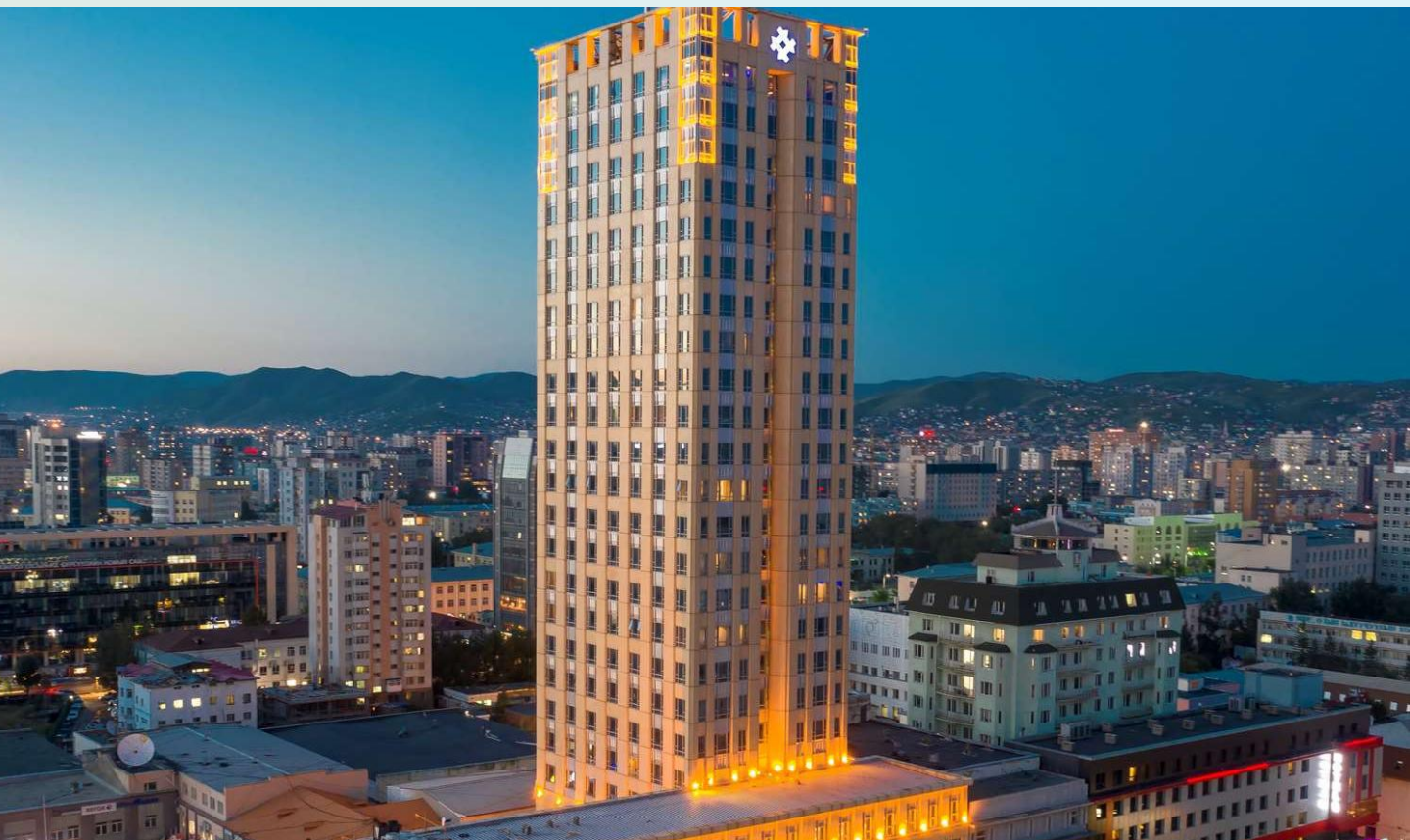

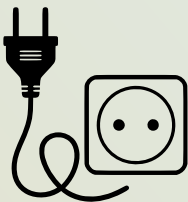
EXCHANGE RATE

Rainfall: July is one of the wettest months in Mongolia, with an average monthly rainfall of approximately 72 mm (2.8 inches).

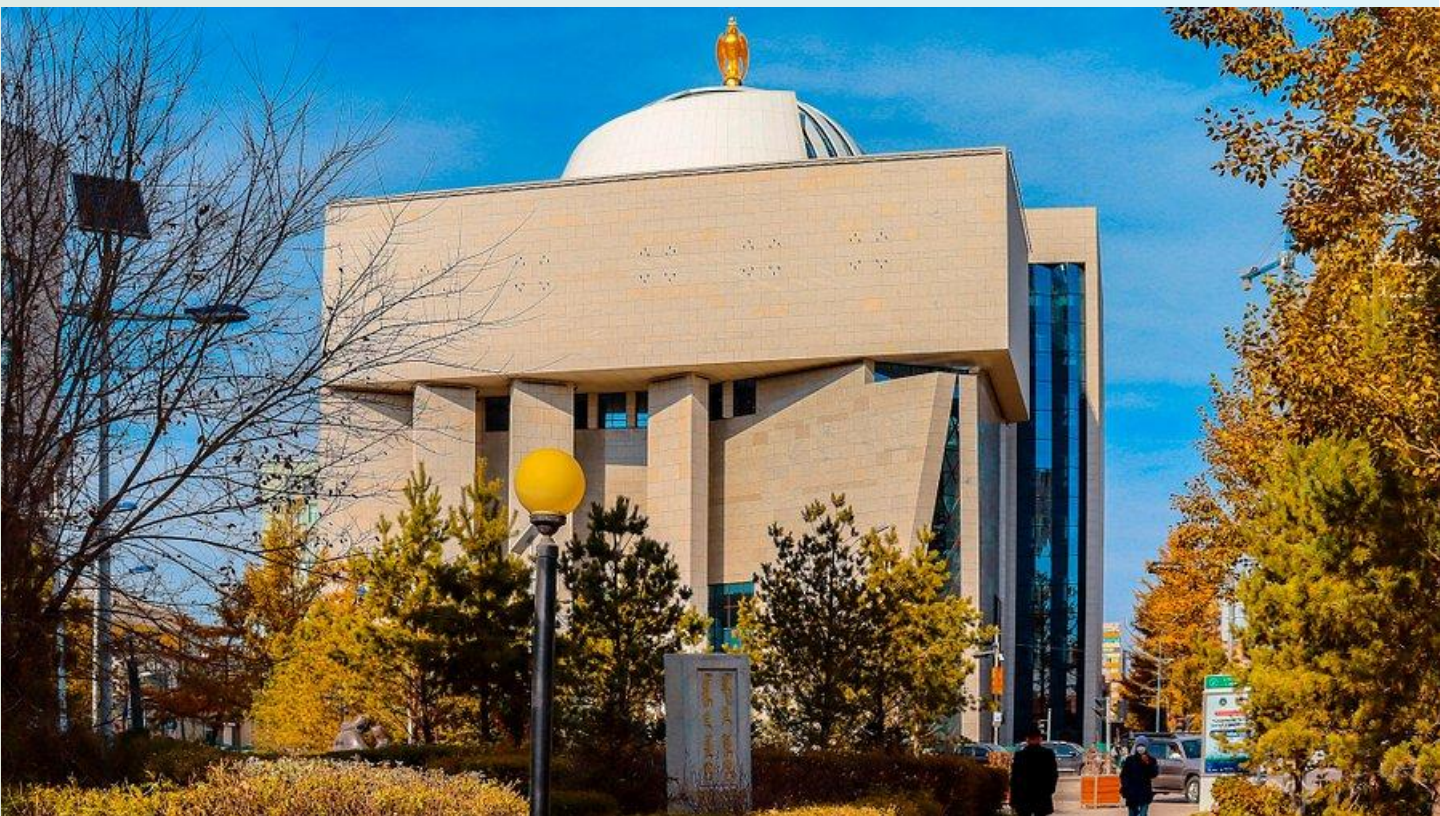

Approximately 9 hours of sunshine per day

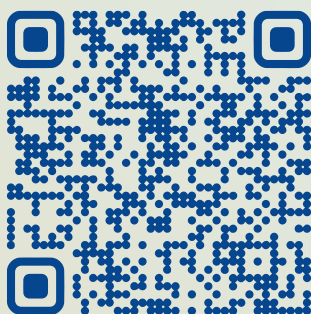

EXPLORING ULAANBAATAR: GENGHIS KHAN NATIONAL MUSEUM



The Chinggis Khaan National Museum in Ulaanbaatar is Mongolia's largest museum, showcasing over 10,000 artifacts related to Genghis Khan and Mongolian history from the Bronze Age to the 20th century. Opened to the public on October 11, 2022, it offers modern exhibits, interactive displays, and stunning architecture near Sukhbaatar Square. A must-visit for those interested in Mongolian culture and heritage.



EXPLORING ULAANBAATAR: GOBI CASHMERE



This is the flagship store of GOBI Cashmere, located in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia. GOBI is one of the world's leading cashmere coat companies, known for producing high-quality garments made from 100% Mongolian cashmere. The modern glass building in the photo is a popular shopping destination for tourists looking for luxury, locally-made products. It offers a wide selection of coats, scarves, sweaters, and other cashmere items.



EXPLORING ULAANBAATAR: STATE DEPARTMENT STORE



Located in the heart of Ulaanbaatar, the State Department Store (Ikh Delguur) is Mongolia's largest and most iconic shopping center, originally established in 1921. It offers a wide range of products—from souvenirs and luxury goods to groceries and electronics—across several floors. A favorite among both tourists and locals, it's a convenient one-stop destination for shopping, dining, and discovering Mongolian-made products.



EXPLORING ULAANBAATAR: CHOIJIN LAMA TEMPLE MUSEUM



Once a Buddhist monastery, the Chojin Lama Temple was built in the early 1900s and now serves as a museum preserving Mongolia's religious and cultural heritage. It features beautifully preserved architecture, intricate wood carvings, and rare Buddhist artifacts, thangka paintings, and masks used in tsam dances. Located in the city center, it offers a peaceful and spiritual experience amid modern surroundings.



EXPLORING ULAANBAATAR: BOGD KHAN PALACE MUSEUM



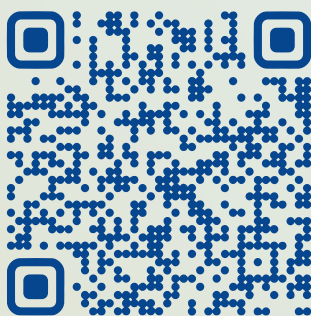
The Bogd Khan Palace Museum, also known as the Winter Palace of the Bogd Khan, is the former home of Mongolia's last king and spiritual leader. Built between 1893 and 1903, it is one of the few royal residences to survive Mongolia's socialist era. The museum complex includes beautifully preserved traditional temples and the king's European-style residence, showcasing royal belongings, thangka art, and cultural treasures. It offers a fascinating glimpse into Mongolia's imperial and religious history.



EXPLORING ULAANBAATAR: DASHCHOILIN MONASTERY



Dashchoilin Monastery is a respected Buddhist temple located near central Ulaanbaatar. Originally part of a larger monastic complex before the socialist purges, it was revived in the 1990s and today serves as an active center of Buddhist learning and ritual. The monastery is known for its peaceful atmosphere, traditional architecture, and chanting ceremonies, offering visitors a chance to experience living Buddhist practice in the city.



EXPLORING ULAANBAATAR: GANDANTEGCHINLEN MONASTERY



Gandantegchinlen Monastery, commonly called “Gandan,” is Mongolia’s largest and most important Buddhist monastery. Built in the 19th century, it miraculously survived the communist-era purges and remains an active center of worship. The monastery is home to the 26.5-meter statue of Avalokitesvara (Migjid Janraisig), one of the tallest indoor Buddha statues in the world. A spiritual and cultural landmark, Gandan offers a powerful glimpse into Mongolian Buddhism and daily monastic life.
