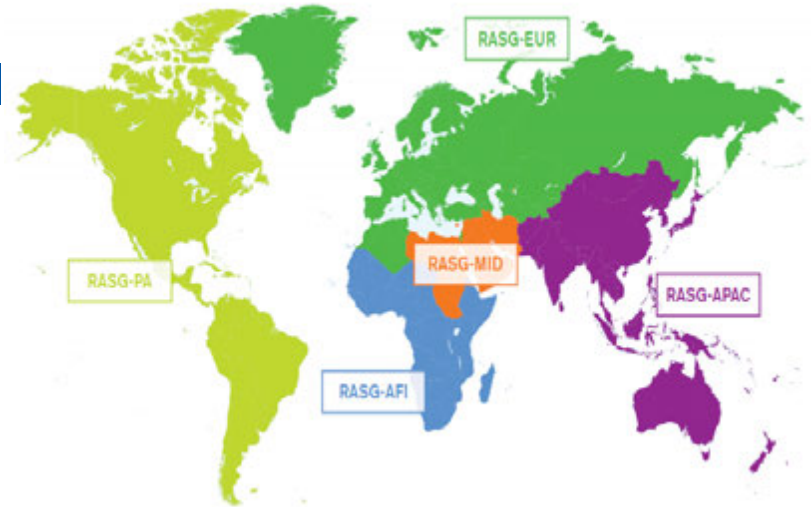

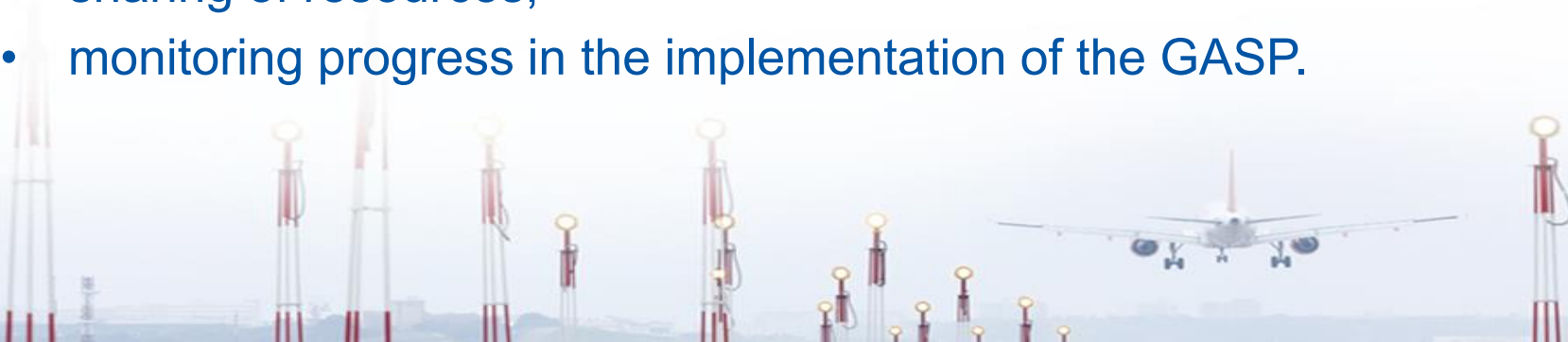
The 190th Session of the ICAO Council approved the establishment of the 5 Regional Aviation Safety Groups (RASGs)





RASG: enhancing safety by

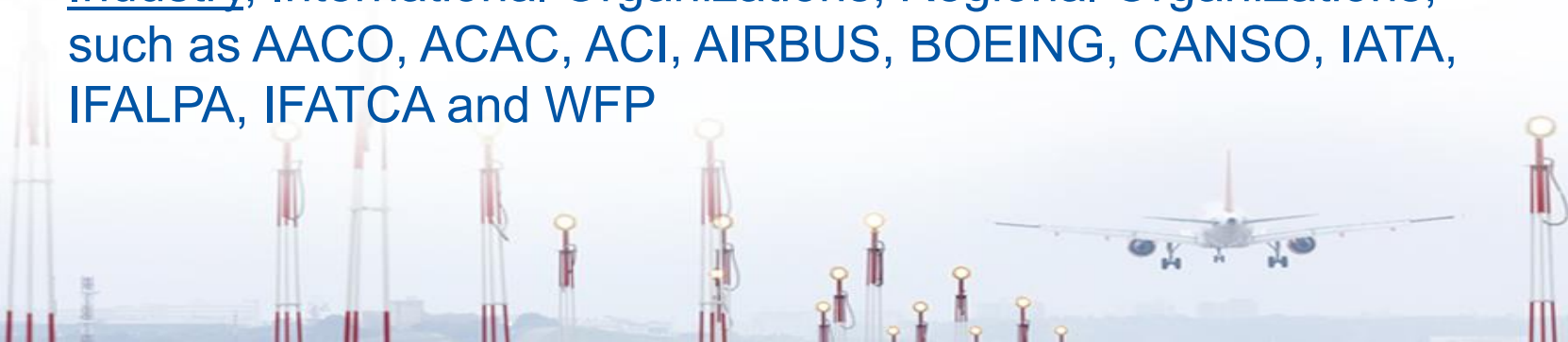
- ensuring effective coordination and cooperation between all stakeholders;

- sharing of resources;
- monitoring progress in the implementation of the GASP.

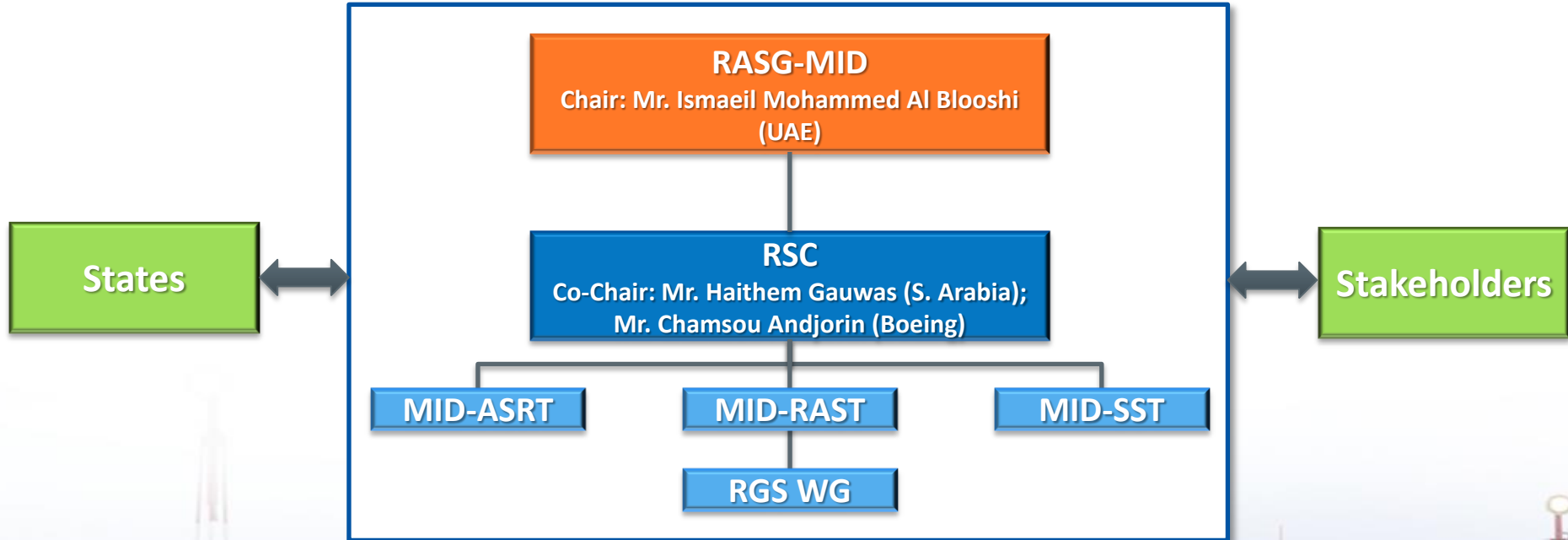




RASG-MID

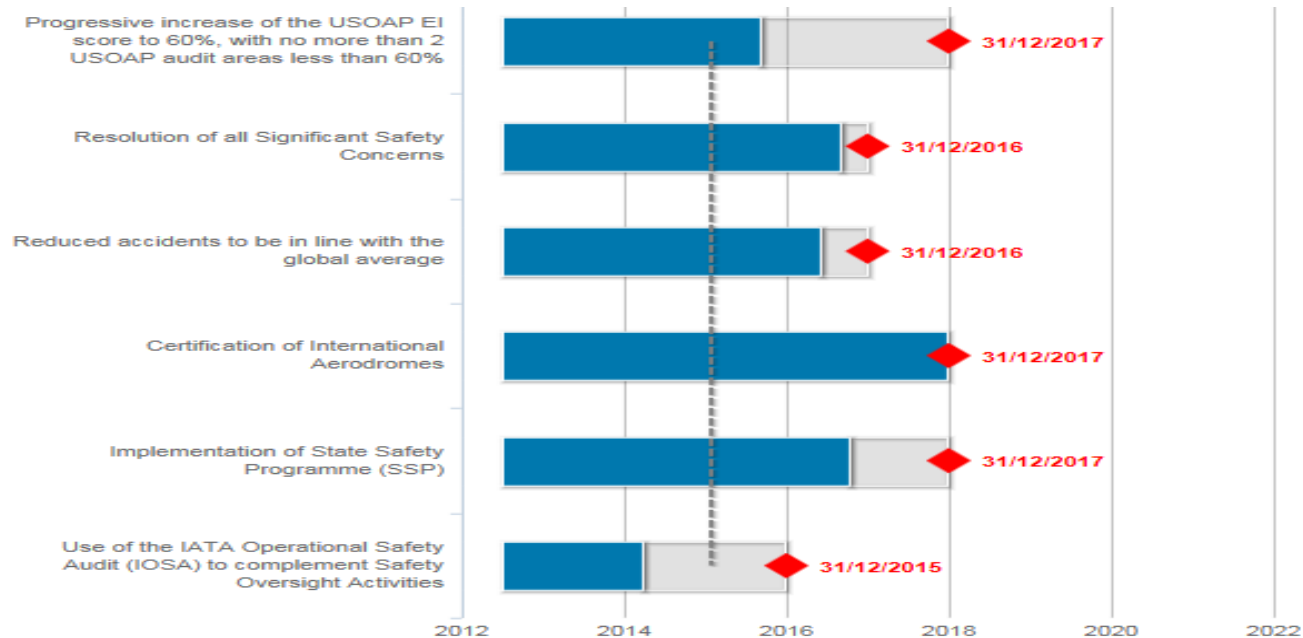
- Established following the Middle East Director Generals meeting agreement DGCA-MID/1, March 2011
- Members includes representatives from all MID States, Industry, International Organizations, Regional Organizations, such as AACO, ACAC, ACI, AIRBUS, BOEING, CANSO, IATA, IFALPA, IFATCA and WFP







RASG-MID Safety Strategy





Deliverables

- Establishment of the MID Runway Safety Go-Team (UAE, Egypt, FAA, IATA, ACI and Dubai Airports Company)
 - 2 mission to Sudan
 - Aerodrome certification
 - Completed training on Aerodrome operations
 - Runway safety teams
- 2 other states have expressed interest in GT support which will be covered in 2016





Deliverables

- Studies/surveys related to safety issues such as Call Sign Confusion and Laser Attacks;
- Support the establishment of the RSOO-MENA
- Accidents and Incidents Analysis Working Group (AIAWG) to review, analyze and categorize accidents and incidents effecting the region and provide an agreed and harmonized regional dataset
- Direct support to assist state with issues related to SSC, development and implementation of CAPs.





Deliverables

- RASG-MID Safety Advisory (RSA)
 - RSA - 001 Guidance for Harmonising the Use & Management of Stop Bars at Airports;
 - RSA - 002 Guidance for Regulatory framework for RST establishment;
 - RSA - 003 Guidance and Model Checklists for Runway Safety Team;
 - RSA - 004 Guidance on call sign similarity;
 - RSA - 005 MID-Region Aerodromes Certification Toolkit”;





Deliverables

- Three MID Annual Safety Reports;
- Two MID Region Safety Summits;
- Second MID Regional Runway Safety Seminar, an Aerodrome Certification Workshop and a Runway Safety Team (RST) Workshop;
- SMS Workshops;
