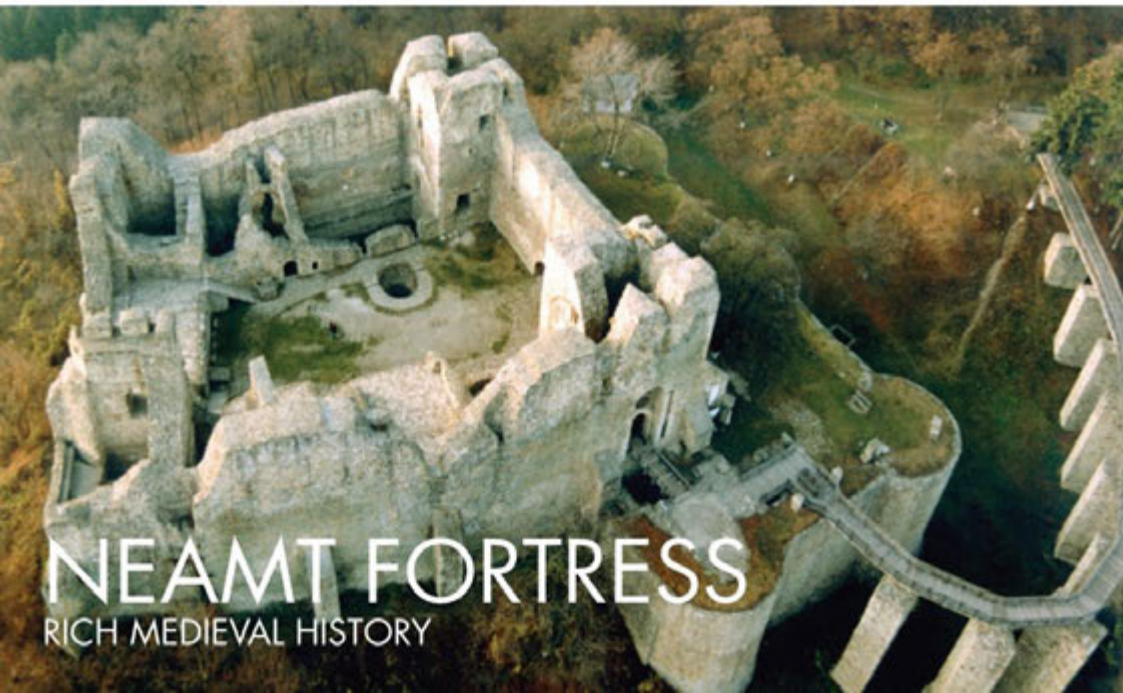

TRAFFIC GROWTH 2015/2016

BENEFITS IN COMMUNITY

- ✈ Unemployment rate: 50% less for university graduated, 30% less for highschool graduated
- ✈ Real estate business: a 60% increase of demand for office rental in 2014 comparing with 2013, 7 times more comparing with 2012
- ✈ 7% of companies reported profit increase in 2014, linked with airport development (Chamber of Commerce and Industry lasi survey)
- ✈ Tourism incomes in lasi County registered a 40% growth in 2015 comparing with 2012 (relevant data compared with national values and prognosis)
- ✈ Confirmed benefits during 2012 – 2015 (associated with 100% traffic growth)

PERSPECTIVES

SHORT TIME BENEFITS

- ✈ Social: individual increase of mobility
- ✈ Economical: direct incomes in community (estimated 500euro/passenger/-year)
- ✈ Increasing in tourism traffic
- ✈ Increasing of local academic attractiveness

LONG TIME BENEFITS

- ✈ Social: life quality improvement, cultural and educational exchanges are favored
- ✈ Economical: attractiveness for (foreign) investors, new job opportunities, lower unemployment rate
