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How to advance and accelerate the implementation of the No Country Left Behind (NCLB) initiatives needed for the modernization of the aviation system? (Session 1)

- Promote the benefits of aviation
- Promote the contribution of aviation to the UN Sustainable Development Goals
- Re-enforce the implementation of global standards through training





How to mobilize resources to overcome constraints and impediments to the partnership and financing for a sustainable aviation future? (Session 2)

- Broaden understanding of benefits of aviation across all levels and departments of government
 - Include aviation in national strategy
- Partnerships and consultation with industry





How to facilitate private and public financing and access to funding for long-term needs? (Session 3)

- Partnerships with industry to build solid business cases for long-term funding
 - Built on common understanding of the benefits of aviation
 - Partnerships and industry consultation to align on business needs and acceptable costs





Summary:

- No silver bullets to accelerate NCLB
- Key steps for success:
 - promoting the benefits of aviation across all departments of government
 - reinforcing the implementation of global standards through training
 - real alignment and partnerships between industry and government
 - solid business cases will help the goals of NCLB
