

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1. ICAO Digital Travel Credential (DTC)

Ongoing Evolution of Automated Document Checks:



Machine-Readable Zone

Introduction of a standardized machine-readable zone enables reading/intake of key passport data elements using a simple "swipe", using, for example, a keyboard or other means; still widely used by borders and other entities today.

Electronic/Biometric Passports

Introduction of chip with digitized traveler data and new security features enables automated "scanning", and verification of, data on the chip using, for example, automated kiosks. Global uptake of these features by borders continues.


Digital Travel Credentials

Introduction of new means of presenting and transmitting digitized traveler data and security features, opening opportunities for more vetting of travellers before their arrivals at points of entry. In progress stay tuned.


1. ICAO Digital Travel Credential (DTC)

2. ICAO DTC (Type 1) – Real Time Learnings



Key inputs thus far:

- **EU Pilots** and **Commission work** around digitization of travel
- **Coming soon**: other domestic inputs
 - Canada is developing a domestic framework for future DTC use;
 - Other similar inputs...?

- DTC works! It can improve efficiency of existing border controls.
- A consensus on transmission protocol for DTC will be critical to global interoperability.
- Chip defect management will be a key consideration for borders wishing to implement.
- IT security data privacy user experience: given more active involvement of the document holder, finding the right balance of these three elements is critical.
- Real world implementation is very different from lab testing.



3. ICBWG DTC State Implementation Guidance Exercise

One of the objectives is to give Member States a better sense of ICAO's current baseline capacities and expectations, versus those optional layers that can help orient them towards the envisioned future state of traveler identification.

- <u>Priority for Phase 1</u>: **DTC (Type 1)** *derivation* **step** generating a DTC-VC using an existing eMRTD.
- OUTCOME "Revision 1" of DTC Guidance to be tabled for endorsement at upcoming *Technical* Advisory Group meeting (November 2025).



Desired Outcomes:	Capacities:

	New for DTC-1: Development of digital identity wallet with ability to receive derived DTC-VC (and made available to clients for download) Authority-controlled kiosk to manage actual DTC-VC derivation, transmit encrypted DTC-VC to client's wallet
