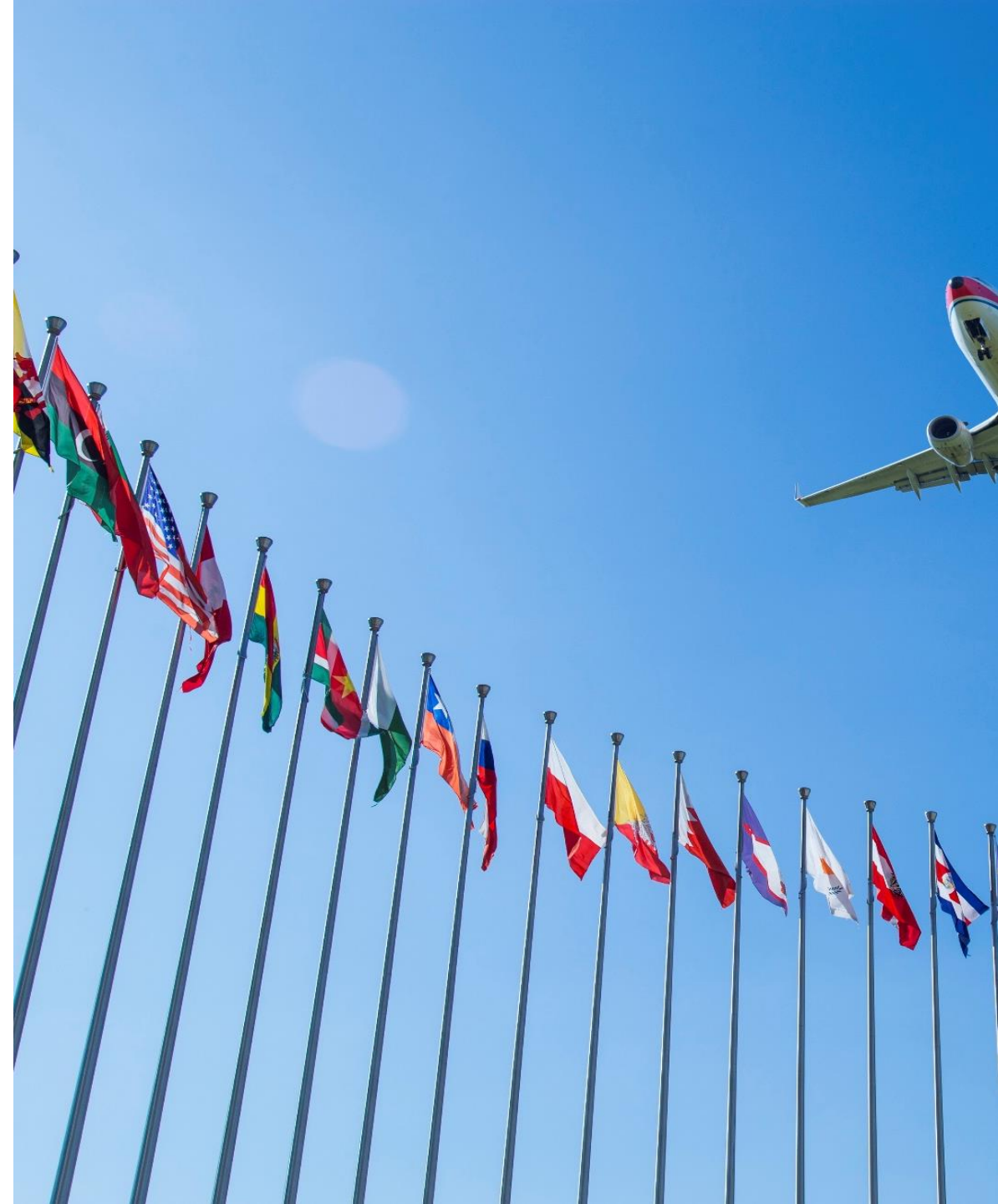

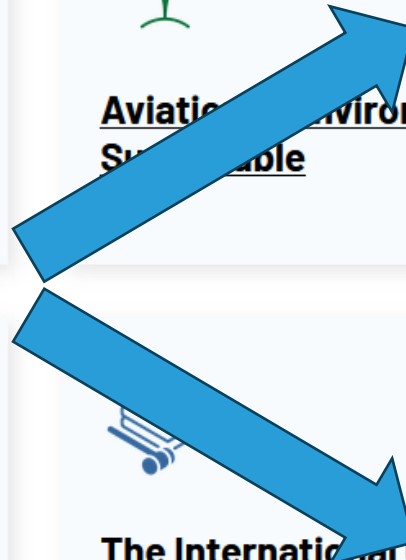

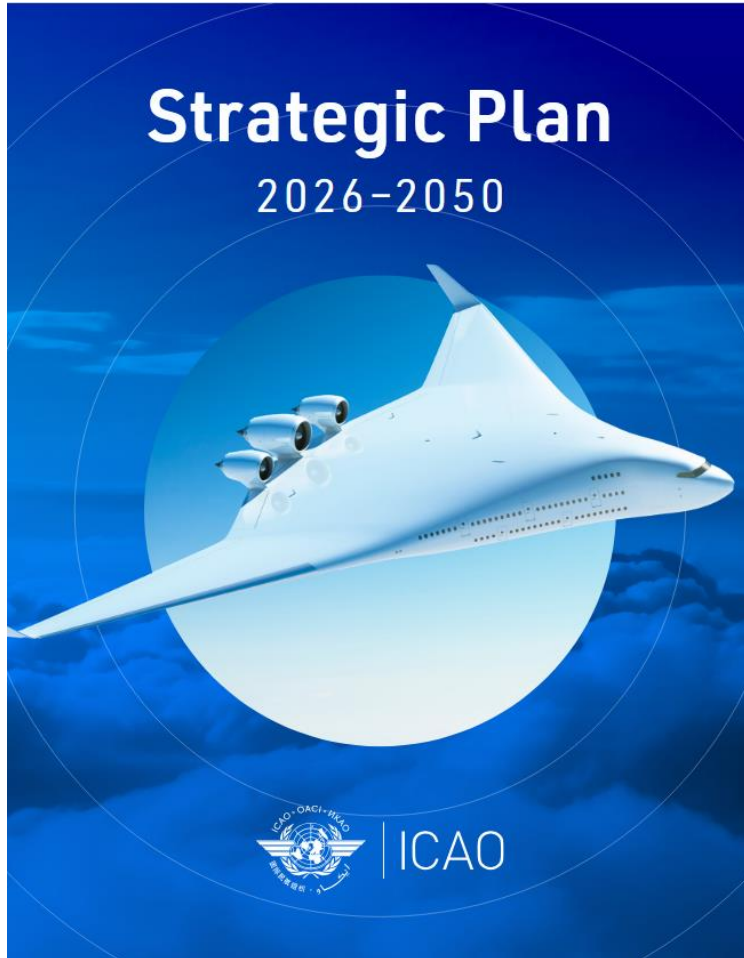

# ICAO Strategic Goals & Facilitation

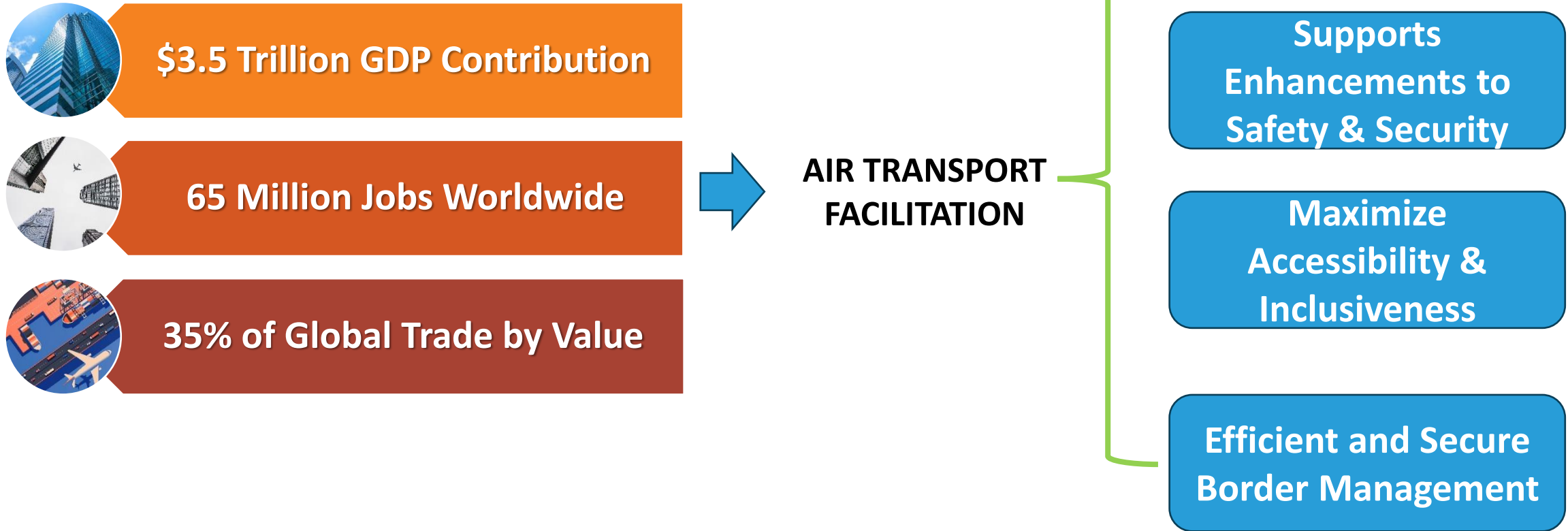


***“Ensure that regulations, procedures and systems facilitate seamless air navigation and travel through airports and borders for all flights, passengers, air cargo and air crew with easily understood, well-coordinated, predictable and affordable access to quality international travel services.”***

For the first time ICAO is centering its goals around the users of air transportation.

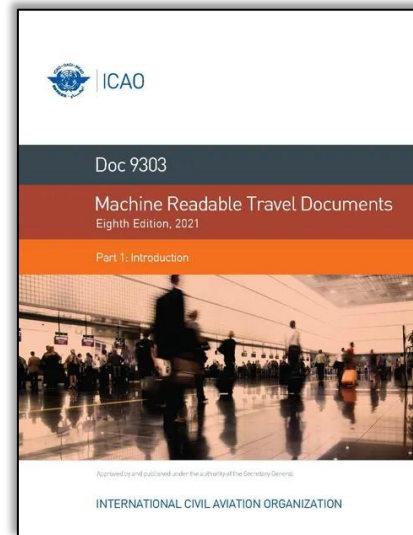
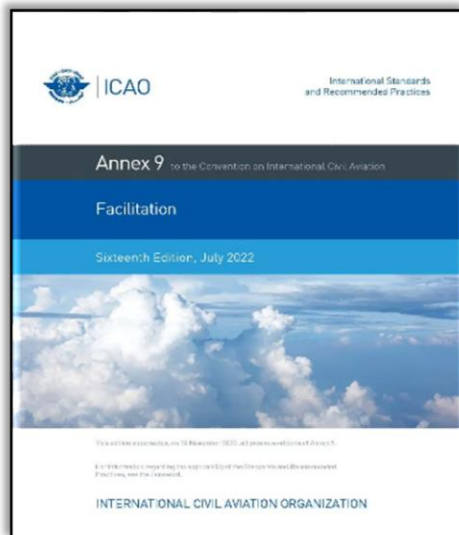

- The core question TRIP answers is: Who is the traveler, and how do we know?
- In an increasingly mobile and complex world, States need to verify identity with certainty. TRIP provides a strategic, standardized framework for secure identity and document management.

- Prevents identity fraud and misuse of travel documents
- Enables efficient and secure border management
- Complies with UN Security Council Resolution
- Supports ICAO Digital Travel Credentials
