Home Page

When you first access the Sliq Harmony application, you'll land on the **“Now Playing”** home page. This view summarizes currently ongoing and upcoming meetings. Selecting a scheduled or live meeting allows you to view the associated media stream.

Streaming Viewer

Each meeting/presentation is labeled with a name and status. Status is indicated on the right side of the meeting and by colored sidebars:

-  **Light Blue:** Adjourned meetings
-  **Green:** Meetings in progress
-  **Dark Blue:** Meetings not yet started
-  **Purple:** Canceled meetings
-  **Orange:** Suspended meetings (shown as ‘Suspended’ on the label)

Navigating Sliq Harmony

- **Now Playing:** Displays currently scheduled meetings
- **New Recordings:** Displays recently adjourned meetings
- **Calendar-Week / Calendar-Month / Calendar-Year:** Displays archived and scheduled meetings. You can select specific dates to view meetings from that day.

- **Filter:** Filters meetings by committee

**Note: Make sure to exit/clear the filter bar to view current meetings.*

To View an In-Progress or Upcoming Meeting

From the Now Playing screen, double-click on the desired meeting:

- If the meeting is in progress, it will begin playing automatically
- If it hasn't started yet, a countdown timer will appear
- The meeting will start automatically at the scheduled time

**Note: If you pause then hit play, the meeting will resume in real-time, not from the point at which it was paused.*

Media Player Tabs

- **Info Tab:** Displays meeting details including location and time
- **Agenda Tab:** Displays timestamps for events during the live meeting
- **Handout Tab:** Displays meeting materials

- On-demand recording
- All six (6) official language tracks of simultaneous interpretation audio with high-definition video
- Supported on both mobile and fixed devices
