Yesterday's meetings, Wednesday, 24 September 2025

First Meeting of the Executive Committee

The Executive Committee opened its First Meeting in closed session at 0900 hours on Wednesday, 24 September 2025 and considered Agenda Item 10 (Contributions in arrears) on the basis of A42 - WP/40 Revision No.1, which provided information on, *inter alia*, the status of contributions in arrears and of Member States that had their voting rights deemed suspended as at 18 September 2025.

Recognizing the importance of ensuring transparency and inclusiveness in the deliberations by all Member States, in accordance with Rule 24 of the *Standing Rules of Procedure of the Assembly of ICAO* (Doc 7600), the Committee agreed that all subsequent meetings of the Executive Committee during the current Assembly would be convened in open session.

The meeting adjourned at 0925 hours.

Third Plenary Meeting

The Third Plenary was held immediately following the First Meeting of the Executive Committee. The Assembly approved the oral report presented by the Chairperson of the Executive Committee on the Committee's consideration of Agenda Item 10 (Contributions in arrears) on the basis of A42-WP/40 Revision No. 1.

Under Agenda Item 8, general statements were then delivered by the Delegations of Singapore, Japan, Brunei Darussalam, Italy, Malaysia, Viet Nam, Brazil, Qatar, Colombia, Germany, Georgia, France, and Estonia.

Prior to adjourning, the Secretary General invited all delegates to the first ICAO High-level Pledging Event: Safe, Secure and Sustainable Aviation for All, which took place in the Assembly Hall, immediately following the close of the Plenary meeting, at 1100 hours.

First Meeting of the Administrative Commission

The Administrative Commission held its first meeting, which commenced at 1330 hours on Wednesday, 24 September 2025 with Mr. Mauricio Ramirez Koppel (Colombia) as its Chairperson. The Officers of the Secretariat were introduced by the Secretary of the Commission, Ms. Olga Nam, thereafter, the President of the Council, Mr. Salvatore Sciacchitano, made a Statement on the Draft Budget for 2026, 2027 and 2028.

Ms. Musayeroh Barrie (Sierra Leone), Ms. Saltanat Tompiyeva (Kazakhstan) and Mr. Angshumali Rastogi (India) were appointed as Vice-Chairpersons, after being nominated by France. All three nominations were seconded by Peru.

The President of the Council introduced the Draft Budget for 2026, 2027 and 2028. This was followed by the presentations by the Secretary General, Mr. Juan Carlos Salazar, as well as the Secretary of the Commission. The Commission considered the presentation and concluded that there were no objections to forwarding the related action items pertaining to the Draft Budget to the Assembly for approval.

In addition to the Draft Budget 2026-2027-2028 (item 30), items 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, and 39, assigned to the Commission, were considered and discussed.

The second meeting of the Commission will be held on Monday, 29 September at 1400 hours. It will begin with Administrative Commission's review of the reports, followed by the Legal Commission, which will convene after the Administrative Commission concludes.

Fourth Meeting of the Plenary

At the Fourth Plenary Meeting, held on Wednesday, 24 September 2025 at 1400 hours, a statement was delivered by the observer from the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE).

Second Meeting of the Executive Committee

At its Second Meeting, held on Wednesday, 24 September 2025 at 1410 hours, immediately following the adjournment of the fourth Plenary meeting, the Executive Committee commenced its consideration of Agenda Item 12 (Facilitation Programmes). While the Committee completed its consideration of the working papers under Batches 1 (Air Transport Facilitation Strategic Matters), 2 (Annex 9 - Facilitation), 3 (ICAO Traveller Identification Programme (TRIP) Strategy and ICAO Public Key Directory (PKD)), 4 (Accessibility in International Civil Aviation), and 5 (Assistance to Aircraft Accident Victims and Their Families (AAAVF)), at the time of adjournment, the Committee had not concluded its consideration of the remaining working papers under this item. It was understood that the Committee would resume its consideration of Agenda Item 12 at a subsequent meeting.

ICAO Treaty Event

The second day of the ICAO Treaty Event took place on 24 September 2025.

Instruments of ratification were deposited by Ghana, Burkina Faso and Saint Lucia for the Protocol Relating to an Amendment to the Convention on International Civil Aviation [Article 50(a)] and the Protocol Relating to an Amendment to the Convention on International Civil Aviation [Article 56], both signed at Montréal on 6 October 2016.

In addition, Saint Lucia also deposited instruments of ratification/accession for the Convention for the Unification of Certain Rules for International Carriage by Air, done at Montreal on 28 May 1999, the Protocol

to Amend the Convention on Offences and Certain Other Acts Committed on Board Aircraft, done at Montréal on 4 April 2014, the Protocol relating to an amendment to the Convention on International Civil Aviation [Final Paragraph, Arabic Text], signed at Montreal on 29 September 1995 and the Protocol relating to an amendment to the Convention on International Civil Aviation [Final Paragraph, Chinese Text], signed at Montreal on 1 October 1998.

Conference Access, Priority Passes and Seating Arrangements

Access to the Assad Kotaite Conference Centre will be restricted to fully accredited delegates, and Resident delegates. The ICAO Secretariat building is restricted to Resident delegations, but Resident delegates with a valid ICAO building badge will be able to escort A42 delegates to their office in the ICAO Secretariat building.

The Seating plans will be displayed at the entrances of conference rooms. Meeting attendants will be available to guide Chief Delegates and their accompanying delegates to their allocated seats.

Priority Passes* will be offered to Delegations (up to four passes for Member States, and up to two for Observers) to access meetings held in the Assembly Hall. Resident Delegates with a valid ICAO building badge can enter the Assembly Hall to accompany their Chief Delegate but will need a Priority Pass to take an assigned seat. Delegates with Priority Passes are required to display these passes while they are seated in their assigned seats in the Assembly Hall. Priority Passes will not be required for attending meetings in the Roberto Kobeh Chamber (CR3). Observer Delegations will each be issued Priority Passes (up to two passes) which will be required for entry to the Assembly Hall.
