Yesterday's meetings, Thursday, 25 September 2025

First and Second Meetings of the Technical Commission

The Technical Commission held its first and second meetings on Thursday, 25 September 2025, at 0900 hours and 1400 hours, respectively, with Mr. Declan Fitzpatrick (Ireland) as its Chairperson. The Commission elected Mr. Luiz Ricardo de Souza Nascimento (Brazil) as First Vice-Chairperson, Ms. Toska Sem (Namibia) as Second Vice Chairperson and Mr. Xuan Miao (China) as Third Vice-Chairperson.

At its first meeting, the Technical Commission considered and completed its work on Agenda Item 23 (Global Aviation Safety and Air Navigation Plans), particularly on the *2026-2028 Edition of the Global Aviation Safety Plan* (GASP, Doc 10004) and the Eighth Edition of the *Global Air Navigation Plan* (GANP, Doc 9750). It then began consideration of Agenda Item 24 (Aviation Safety and Air Navigation Priority Initiatives), addressing working papers under groups 1 and 2.

During its second meeting, consideration of Agenda Item 24 continued in the afternoon with working papers under groups 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, as well as part of group 8.

The third and fourth meetings will be held on Friday, 26 September 2025, at 0900 and 1400 hours, respectively, in Conference Room 3 on the 1st Floor. The Commission will resume its consideration of Agenda Item 24, covering the remaining working papers under groups 8 to 18, and will commence its work on Agenda Item 25 (Other issues to be considered by the Technical Commission).

First Meeting of the Economic Commission

The Economic Commission, at its first meeting on Thursday, 25 September 2025 at 0900 hours, presided by its Chairperson, Mr. Silas Udahemuka (Rwanda), elected Mr. Tiago Pereira (Brazil) and Ms. Ana Vieira da Mata (Portugal) as First and Second Vice-Chairpersons respectively.

Under Agenda Item 26, Economic Development of Air Transport, the Commission initiated consideration of A42-WP/42 Consolidated Statement of Continuing ICAO Policies in the Air Transport Field presented by the Council and then considered the working papers presented by States related to liberalization and regulation of International Air Transport, taxation in international air transport and consumer protection. At the time of adjournment at 1210 hours, the Commission did not complete its deliberations on this item.

The Commission agreed to resume its work at its second meeting on Saturday, 27 September 2025 at 1400 hours.

First Meeting of the Legal Commission

The Legal Commission, at its first meeting on Thursday, 25 September 2025, at 1400 hours, presided by its Chairperson, Mr. Jae Woon Lee (Republic of Korea), elected Dr. Griselda Delia Capaldo (Argentina) and Ms. Machteld Cambridge (Netherlands) as its First and Second Vice-Chairpersons, respectively.

The Commission completed consideration of Agenda Items 28 and 29.

Third Meeting of the Executive Committee

At its Third Meeting, held on Thursday, 25 September 2025 at 1700 hours, the Executive Committee resumed its consideration of Agenda Item 12 (Facilitation Programmes), completing its consideration of the remaining working papers under Batches 6 (Facilitation Oversight and Capacity Building) and 7 (Trafficking in Persons and Irregular Migration). In concluding its deliberations, the Committee agreed to recommend to the Plenary for adoption the following amended Resolutions: *Consolidated statement of continuing ICAO policies related to facilitation*; *Strategy on disaster risk reduction and response mechanism in aviation*; *Accessibility in international civil aviation*; *Assistance to victims of aviation accidents and their families*; and *Development and implementation of facilitation provisions - Combatting human trafficking*.

ICAO Treaty Event

The ICAO Treaty Event initially scheduled for 23 and 24 September 2025 was extended for an additional day on 25 September 2025.

South Africa deposited an instrument of ratification for the Protocol to Amend the Convention on Offences and Certain Other Acts Committed on Board Aircraft, done at Montréal on 4 April 2014.

Conference Access, Priority Passes and Seating Arrangements

Access to the Assad Kotaite Conference Centre will be restricted to fully accredited delegates, and Resident delegates. The ICAO Secretariat building is restricted to Resident delegations, but Resident delegates with a valid ICAO building badge will be able to escort A42 delegates to their office in the ICAO Secretariat building.

The Seating plans will be displayed at the entrances of conference rooms. Meeting attendants will be available to guide Chief Delegates and their accompanying delegates to their allocated seats.

Priority Passes* will be offered to Delegations (up to four passes for Member States, and up to two for Observers) to access meetings held in the Assembly Hall. Resident Delegates with a valid ICAO building badge can enter the Assembly Hall to accompany their Chief Delegate but will need a Priority Pass to take an assigned seat. Delegates with Priority Passes are required to display these passes while they are seated in their assigned seats in the Assembly Hall. Priority Passes will not be required for attending meetings in the Roberto Kobeh Chamber (CR3). Observer Delegations will each be issued Priority Passes (up to two passes) which will be required for entry to the Assembly Hall.
