Yesterday's meetings, Friday, 26 September 2025

Fourth and Fifth Meetings of the Executive Committee

At its Fourth Meeting, held on Friday, 26 September 2025 at 0900 hours, the Executive Committee considered and completed its work on Agenda Item 15 (Environmental Protection – General provisions, Aircraft Noise and Local Air Quality). In doing so, the Committee agreed to recommend to the Plenary for adoption the revised *Consolidated statement of continuing ICAO policies and practices related to environmental protection – General provisions, noise and local air quality*, as proposed by the Council in WP/24, and amended during the discussion.

The Executive Committee then commenced consideration of Agenda Item 16 (Environmental Protection – International Aviation and Climate Change). At the time of adjournment, the Committee had not completed its consideration of this item, and as such, agreed to continue its discussion at the next meeting of the Executive Committee, to be held later in the afternoon at 1400 hours.

At its Fifth Meeting, held on Friday, 26 September 2025 at 1400 hours, the Executive Committee considered and completed its work on Agenda Item 16 (Environmental Protection – International Aviation and Climate Change), as well as Agenda Item 17 (Carbon Offsetting and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation (CORSIA)). In concluding its deliberations, the Committee agreed to recommend to the Plenary for adoption the revised *Consolidated statement of continuing ICAO policies and practices related to environmental protection – Climate Change*, as proposed by the Council in WP/27, and amended of the course of the Committee's consideration, as well as the *Consolidated statement of continuing ICAO policies and practices related to environmental protection – Carbon Offsetting and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation (CORSIA)*.

The Executive Committee also completed its consideration of Agenda items 11 (Annual Reports of the Council to the Assembly for 2022, 2023 and 2024) and 19 (Multilingualism at ICAO).

Third and Fourth Meetings of the Technical Commission

The Technical Commission held its third and fourth meetings on Friday, 26 September 2025, at 0900 and 1400 hours, respectively, with the fourth meeting extended beyond 1700 hours. During these meetings, the Commission considered and completed its work on Agenda Item 24 (Aviation Safety and Air Navigation Priority Initiatives), covering working papers under groups 8 to 18, and completed its consideration of Agenda Item 25 (Other issues to be considered by the Technical Commission), groups 1 to 4.

The Technical Commission will begin its review of the report materials for Agenda Items 23, 24, and 25 at its fifth meeting, which is scheduled for Monday, 29 September 2025, at 0900 hours, in Conference Room 3, First Floor.

Please note that access to the app is exclusively reserved for **registered A42 participants**. The app offers a range of features to help you navigate the event, stay informed, and engage with sessions and updates in real time.

Conference Access, Priority Passes and Seating Arrangements

Access to the Assad Kotaite Conference Centre will be restricted to fully accredited delegates, and Resident delegates. The ICAO Secretariat building is restricted to Resident delegations, but Resident delegates with a valid ICAO building badge will be able to escort A42 delegates to their office in the ICAO Secretariat building.

The Seating plans will be displayed at the entrances of conference rooms. Meeting attendants will be available to guide Chief Delegates and their accompanying delegates to their allocated seats.

Priority Passes* will be offered to Delegations (up to four passes for Member States, and up to two for Observers) to access meetings held in the Assembly Hall. Resident Delegates with a valid ICAO building badge can enter the Assembly Hall to accompany their Chief Delegate but will need a Priority Pass to take an assigned seat. Delegates with Priority Passes are required to display these passes while they are seated in their assigned seats in the Assembly Hall. Priority Passes will not be required for attending meetings in the Roberto Kobeh

Chamber (CR3). Observer Delegations will each be issued Priority Passes (up to two passes) which will be required for entry to the Assembly Hall.
