Saturday's meetings, 27 September 2025

Fifth Meeting of the Plenary

At the Fifth Plenary Meeting, held on Saturday, 27 September, at 0900 hours, Parts 1 and 2 of the election of the Council were conducted under Agenda Item 5. Prior to proceeding to the vote, the Chairperson of the Credentials Committee (Greece), presented the oral interim report of the Committee, in which he indicated that at the time of the Committee's third meeting, original credentials in the proper form had been received from 191 Member States, of which 6 were in arrears and had their voting rights suspended in the Assembly.

With 184 States voting and 184 votes cast, the number of votes required for election in Part 1 was at least 93. There were 11 candidates for 11 seats in this Part, and 10 were elected on the first electronic ballot as follows: Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, the United Kingdom and the United States.

In Part 2, there were 13 candidates for 12 seats, and 12 were elected on the first electronic ballot. With 184 States voting and 184 votes cast, the number of votes required for election in Part 2 was at least 93. The following States were elected: Argentina, Colombia, Denmark, Egypt, India, Mexico, Nigeria, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, South Africa, Spain and Switzerland.

The President of the Assembly announced that the election to the Council in the third Part would be held at the Sixth Plenary Meeting on Tuesday, 30 September, at 1400 hours. In noting that one additional seat remained unfilled following the election in Part 1, the Assembly decided to amend the decision taken during the first Plenary meeting on the maximum number of candidates to be elected in each part (A42-WP/2 Revision No. 1, refers), such that the unfilled seat in Part 1 would be reallocated to Part 3. It was therefore agreed that up to 14 candidates could now be elected to the Council under Part 3. The deadline for notifications of candidature, which should be submitted in writing to the Secretary General, was set at 1052 hours on Monday, 29 September 2025.

The remainder of the meeting was devoted to Agenda Item 8, with general statements delivered by the Delegations of: Ghana, Kazakhstan, Uganda, Morocco, Tuvalu, Burkina Faso, New Zealand, Bahrain, Switzerland, Cuba, Argentina, United Arab Emirates, Uruguay, Greece and Poland.

Sixth Meeting of the Executive Committee

At its Sixth Meeting, held on Saturday, 27 September at 1400 hours, the Executive Committee considered and completed its work on Agenda Items 18 (Capacity Development and Implementation Support – Policy and Activities), 20 (Innovation in Aviation) and 21 (Next Generation of Aviation Professionals (NGAP) initiative).

It was noted that the next meeting of the Executive Committee would be held on Monday, 29 September 2025 at 0900 hours.

Second Meeting of the Economic Commission

The Economic Commission, at its second meeting held on Saturday, 27 September 2025 at 1400 hours, resumed its work and completed its consideration of all working papers submitted by member States under:

- Agenda Item 26, Economic Development of Air Transport; and
- Agenda Item 27, Other Issues to be Considered by the Economic Commission.

The Commission agreed to continue its work on the review of the revised Consolidated Statement of Continuing ICAO Policies in the Air Transport Field as well as its Report, at its third meeting on Tuesday, 30 September 2025 at 0900 hours.

Conference Access, Priority Passes and Seating Arrangements

Access to the Assad Kotaite Conference Centre will be restricted to fully accredited delegates, and Resident delegates. The ICAO Secretariat building is restricted to Resident delegations, but Resident delegates with a valid ICAO building badge will be able to escort A42 delegates to their office in the ICAO Secretariat building.

The Seating plans will be displayed at the entrances of conference rooms. Meeting attendants will be available to guide Chief Delegates and their accompanying delegates to their allocated seats.

Priority Passes will be offered to Delegations (up to four passes for Member States, and up to two for Observers) to access meetings held in the Assembly Hall. Resident Delegates with a valid ICAO building badge can enter the Assembly Hall to accompany their Chief Delegate but will need a Priority Pass to take an assigned seat. Delegates with Priority Passes are required to display these passes while they are seated in their assigned seats in the Assembly Hall. Priority Passes will not be required for attending meetings in the Roberto Kobeh Chamber (CR3). Observer Delegations will each be issued Priority Passes (up to two passes) which will be required for entry to the Assembly Hall.
