Yesterday's meetings, 30 September 2025**Ninth Meeting of the Executive Committee**

At its ninth meeting, held on Tuesday, 30 September at 0900 hours, the Executive Committee resumed its deliberations on the working papers under Batch 3 (Matters concerning infractions of the Chicago Convention by contracting States pertaining to Global Navigation Satellite System (GNSS) Radio Frequency Interference (RFI)) of Agenda Item 22 (Other high-level policy issues to be considered by the Executive Committee).

Invoking Rule 47 of the Standing Rules of Procedure of the Assembly, the Russian Federation, seconded by Belarus and Eritrea, moved to request a secret ballot vote in relation to working paper WP/553. As there were no objections, and following subsequent debate, the Committee proceeded with the secret ballot vote on

whether to recommend to the Plenary to adopt the draft Resolution as stipulated in the Appendix to WP/553. Of the 153 ballots deposited, 89 were in favour, 19 opposed, 42 abstained, with 1 invalid and 2 blank ballots. The vote was carried in the affirmative, indicating the Committee's support for recommending the Resolution appended to WP/553 to the Plenary for adoption.

In concluding its deliberations under Batch 3, the Committee then turned to consider the remaining items on its Order of Business, completing its consideration of the working papers under Batch 4 (Unilateral measures). At the time of adjournment, as the Committee had not completed its consideration of working papers under Agenda Item 22, it was agreed that the Committee would resume its discussions in this regard at a meeting to be held later that evening at 1700 hours.

Sixth Meeting of the Plenary

At the Sixth Plenary Meeting, held on Tuesday, 30 September 2025, at 1400 hours, Part 3 of the election of the Council was conducted under Agenda Item 5. It was recalled that in light of the decision of the Assembly to re-allocate the unfilled seat on the Council from Part 1 of the election to Part 3, there were up to 14 candidates that could now be elected under Part 3.

With 183 States voting and 183 votes cast, the number of votes required for election in Part 3 was at least 92. There were 15 candidates for 14 seats in this Part, and 14 were elected on the first electronic ballot as follows: Angola, Belize, Cuba, Ecuador, Equatorial Guinea, Malaysia, Mali, Morocco, Poland, Qatar, Republic of Korea, Uganda, United Arab Emirates and Uruguay. It was highlighted that in the 81-year history of ICAO, it was the first time that Belize and Mali had been elected to the Council.

The remainder of the meeting was devoted to Agenda Item 8, with general statements being delivered by the Delegations of: Niger, Namibia, Zimbabwe, Eswatini, Dominican Republic, Bangladesh, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Thailand, Kuwait, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Sudan, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Lithuania, Paraguay, Jamaica, United Republic of Tanzania, Guatemala and Eritrea. A statement was also delivered by the observer of the Latin American Civil Aviation Commission (LACAC).

Tenth Meeting of the Executive Committee

At the tenth meeting of the Executive Committee, held on Tuesday, 30 September at 1700 hours, the Committee returned to consider the working papers remaining under Agenda Item 22 (Other high-level policy issues to be considered by the Executive Committee) in Batches 5 (Other policy matters pertaining to international air transport) and 6 (Military aggression endangering international civil aviation). The Committee completed its work thereunder.

The Committee then considered and approved the draft Reports of the Executive Committee on Agenda Items 11 (Annual Reports of the Council to the Assembly for 2022, 2023 and 2024) and 15 (Environmental Protection – General provisions, Aircraft Noise and Local Air Quality), as contained in WP/643 and WP/647, respectively, for submission to the Plenary.

Conference Access, Priority Passes and Seating Arrangements

Access to the Assad Kotaite Conference Centre will be restricted to fully accredited delegates, and Resident delegates. The ICAO Secretariat building is restricted to Resident delegations, but Resident delegates with a valid ICAO building badge will be able to escort A42 delegates to their office in the ICAO Secretariat building.

The Seating plans will be displayed at the entrances of conference rooms. Meeting attendants will be available to guide Chief Delegates and their accompanying delegates to their allocated seats.

Priority Passes will be offered to Delegations (up to four passes for Member States, and up to two for Observers) to access meetings held in the Assembly Hall. Resident Delegates with a valid ICAO building badge can enter the Assembly Hall to accompany their Chief Delegate but will need a Priority Pass to take an assigned seat. Delegates with Priority Passes are required to display these passes while they are seated in their assigned seats in the Assembly Hall. Priority Passes will not be required for attending meetings in the Roberto Kobeh Chamber (CR3). Observer Delegations will each be issued Priority Passes (up to two passes) which will be required for entry to the Assembly Hall.
