1 Introduction

1.1 The E/CAR Working Group envisaged that there was a need for the states of the Eastern Caribbean with Radar Head Sites to agree on sharing the relevant data among themselves.

2. Background

2.1 A Radar Data Sharing Task Force with France as the coordinator was created to establish a common, seamless surveillance image in the Eastern Caribbean.

2.2 The Task Force met on one occasion in Martinique in June 1999 and to this date no other meetings have been convened.

3.1 The Meeting is therefore invited to examine any progress of the work of the Task Force with a view to having this outstanding project brought to an acceptable conclusion.
