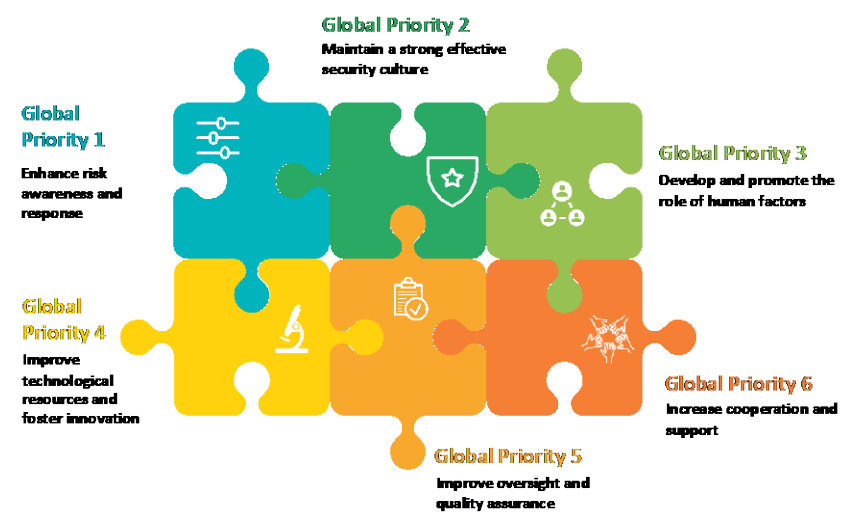

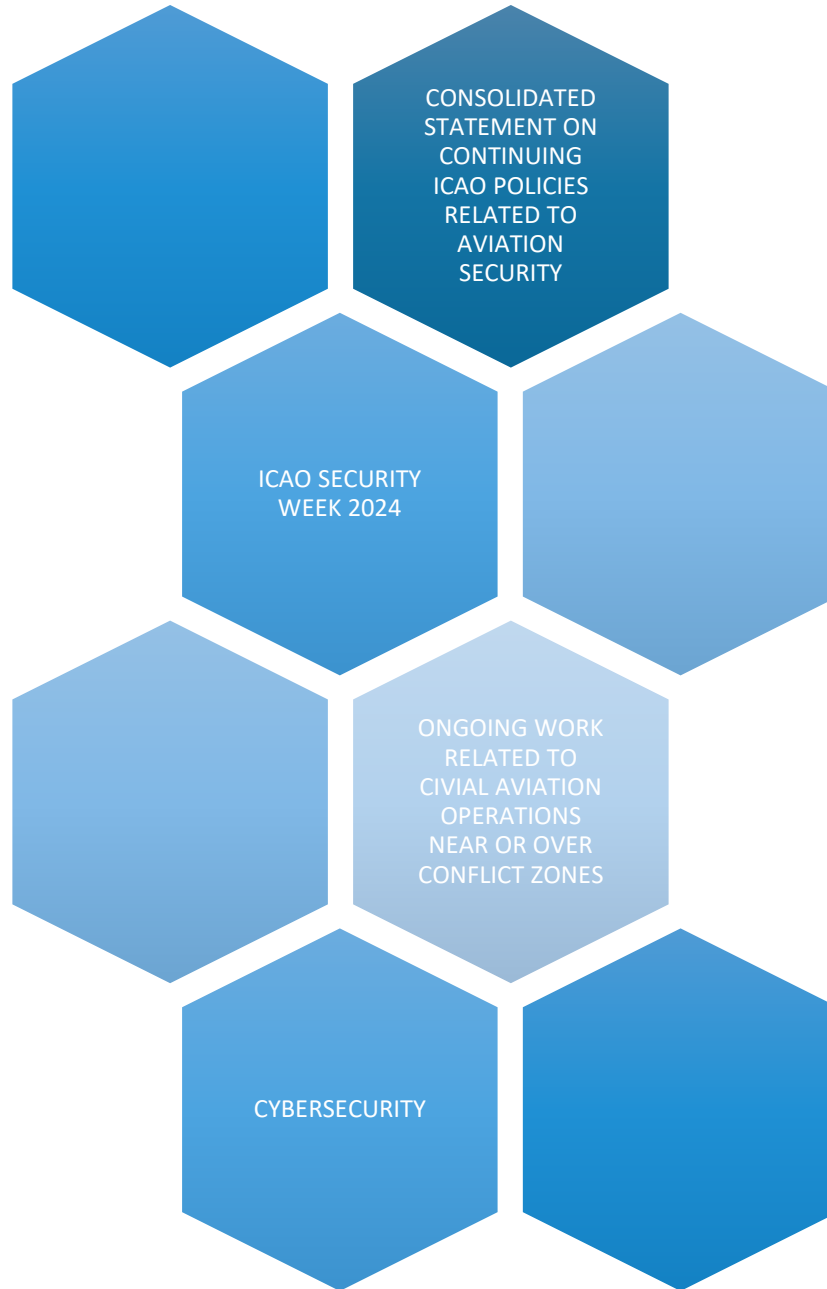

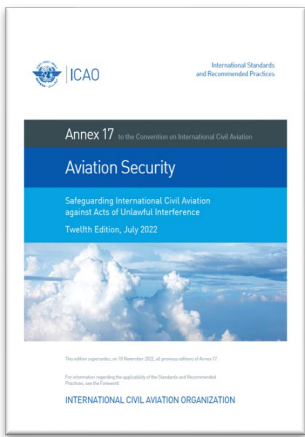

Apr 2025

Revision

- Standard 4.3.1 (to allow recognition of OSS for aircraft searches and checks)
- RP 2.5.2 on human factors changed to 3.4.8
- Inclusion of definitions : human factors, human performance, transit pax and bag, transfer pax and bag
- Amendment 19 presented to the Council in Nov 2025
- State consultation – 3 months
- Final review – Spring 2026

Implementation Support and Development – Security (ISD-SEC) Programme

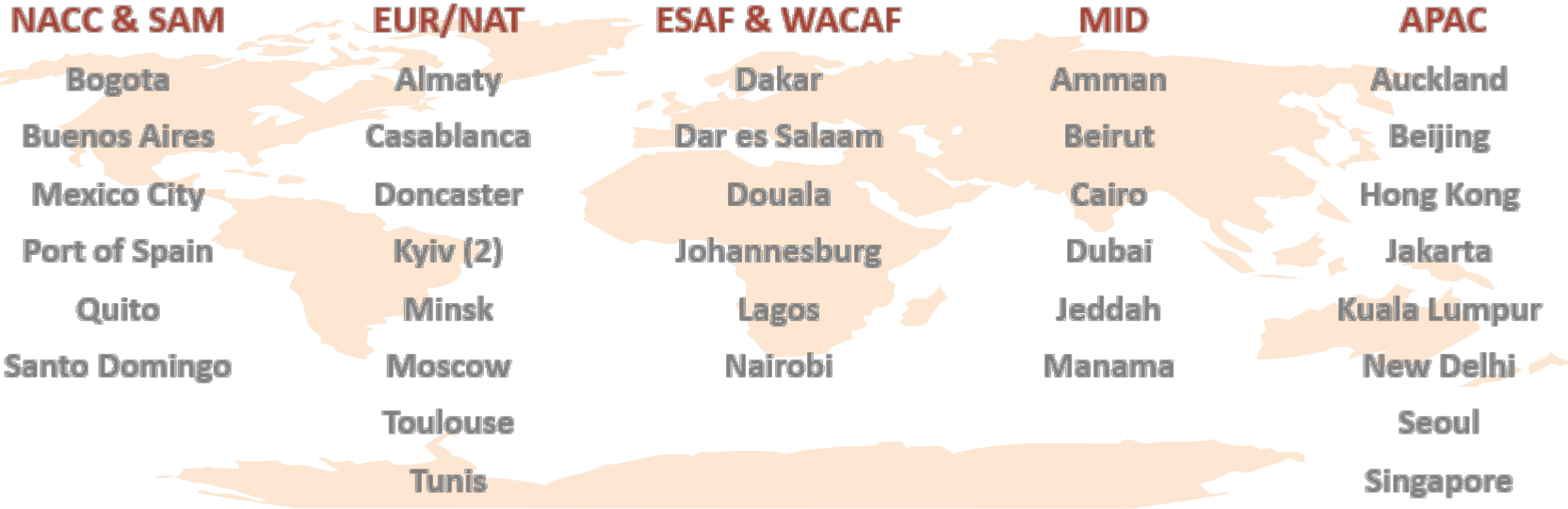


Implementation Support and Development - Security (ISD-SEC) Programme



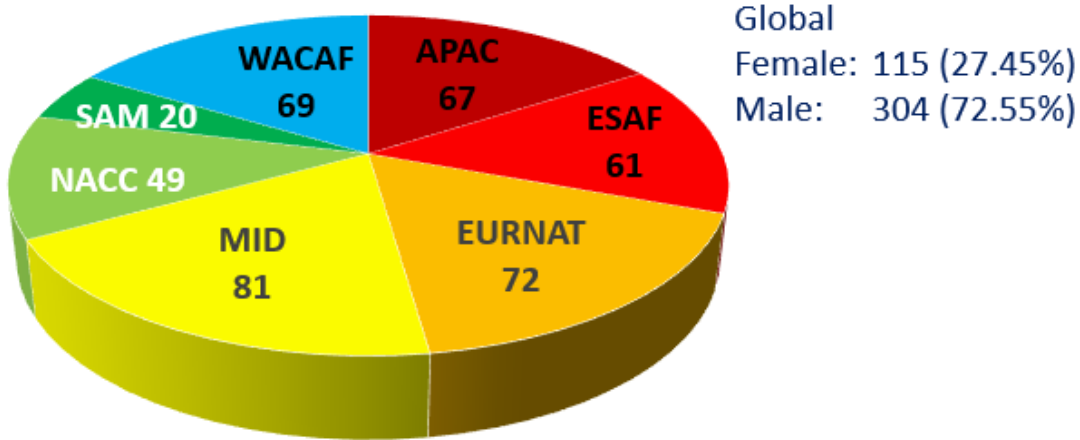
ISD-SEC organizes its assistance efforts through **Aviation Security Improvement Plans (ASIPs)**, which provide a multi-phase framework tailored to each State's specific needs. ASIPs are developed collaboratively with the national AVSEC authority and stakeholders, defining the scope, responsibilities, deliverables, and funding for each activity. They ensure structured monitoring, enable coordinated action, and establish clear milestones to measure progress in meeting AVSEC obligations. ASIPs also foster political commitment, align new and existing assistance activities, and are collectively developed, implemented, and managed—ensuring that success ultimately belongs to the State.

AVSEC Assistance Achievements 2024

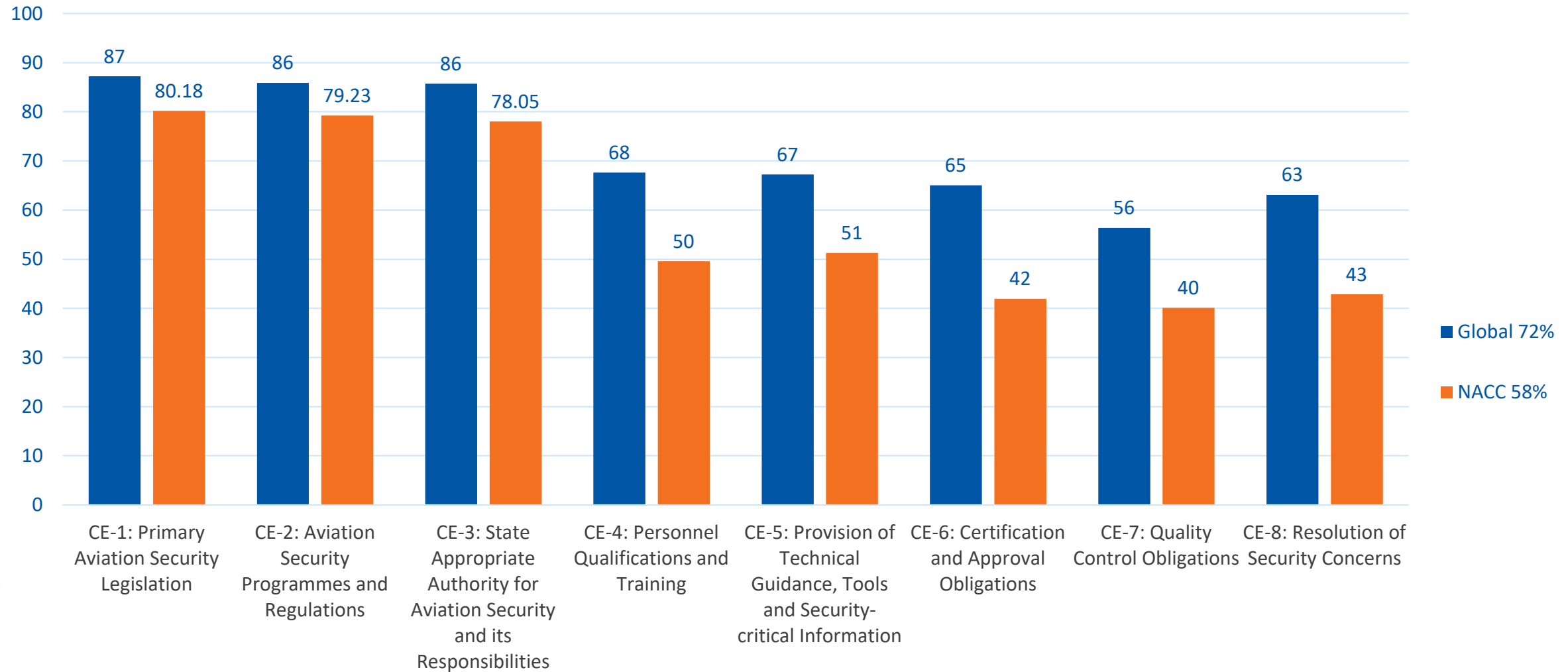
- In 2024, **108** ICAO HQ-supported AVSEC assistance activities, benefitting **1595** AVSEC specialists from **85** Member States

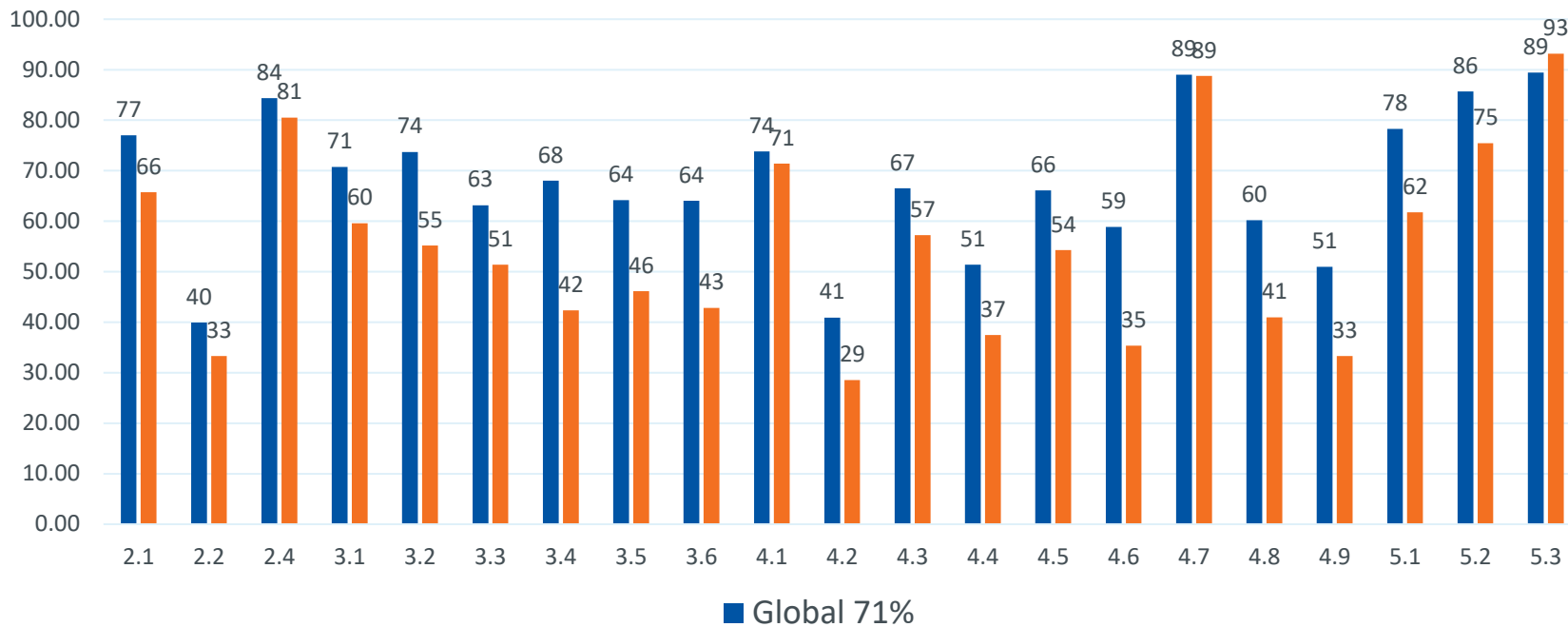
*(Assistance activities were increased by **35%** and the number of benefitted specialists was risen by **57%** by a comparison with achievements in 2023)*

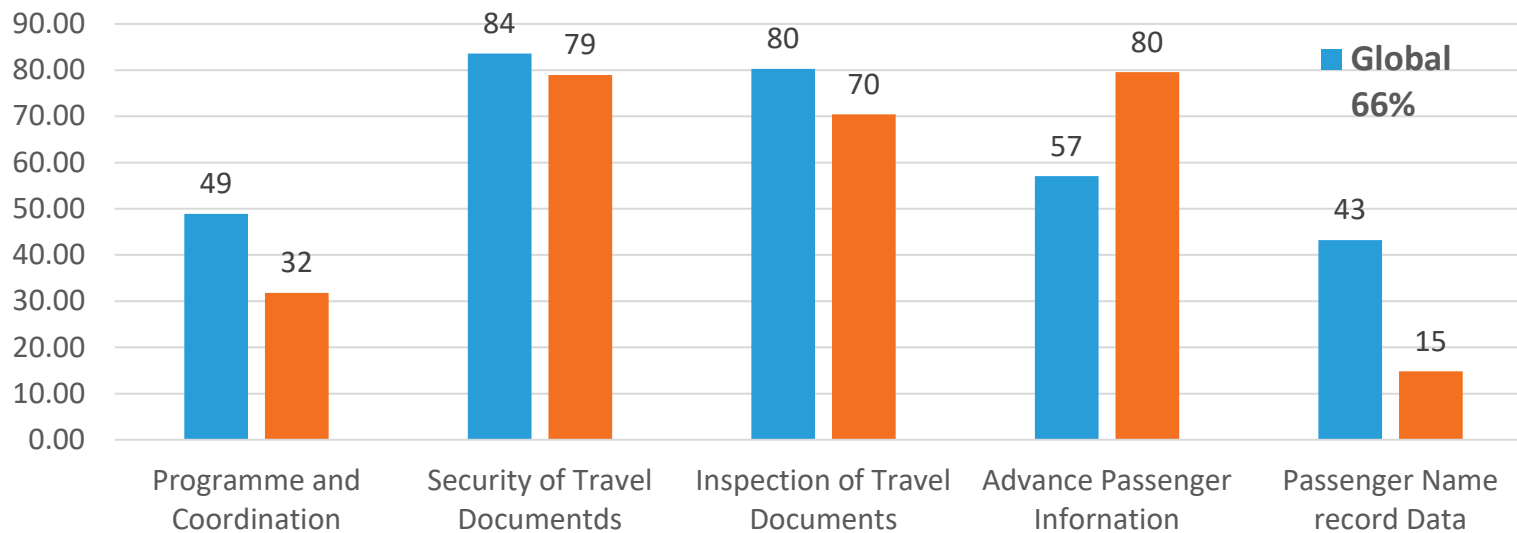
Regional Audit Results – Sustainability indicator - NACC





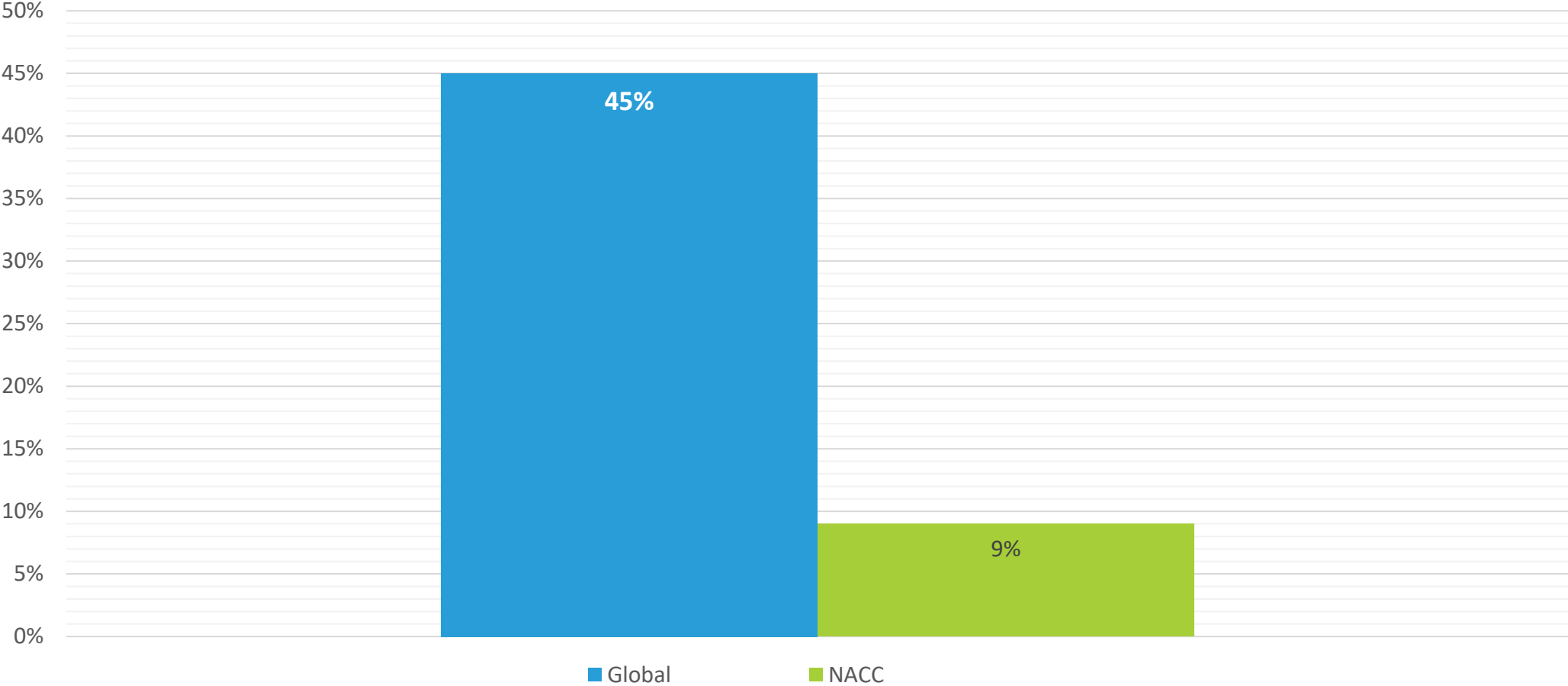
Regional Audit Results – NACC Compliance with Annex 17

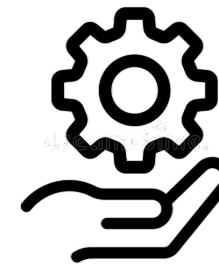
