Agenda Item 1: Adoption of the Provisional Agenda and Schedule

Under this agenda item, the Meeting shall review the agenda and schedule and adopt them. The objectives and overall expectations of the meeting will be presented.

Agenda Item 2: Follow-up on Valid Conclusions and Decisions from NCMCs meeting 2024

Under this agenda item, the Meeting will conduct a review the status of valid conclusions and decisions from the 2024 NCMCs meeting

Agenda Item 3 GASP updates and NACC USOAP EI status

Under this agenda item, the most relevant issues related to the USOAP will be discussed in the framework of the new Global Aviation Safety Plan (GASP) and the recommendations of the ICAO Assembly (A42), and additionally an overview of the performance of the NAM/CAR region in terms of Effective Implementation (EI).

Agenda Item 4: Analysis of AGA Effective Implementation in the NAM/CAR Region and challenges.

Under this agenda item, the Secretariat will analyse the effective implementation of Safety Oversight in the Aerodrome Area (AGA) of the Region, based on the data available on the ICAO USOAP portal. The analysis will highlight areas of strength and opportunities for improvement, including improvements in regulatory frameworks, supervisory processes, and technical staff training. The session will also outline regional trends and specific challenges affecting OGP oversight and service delivery.

Agenda Item 5: AIG Implementation and challenges in our region

Under this agenda item, the Secretariat will present the actions taken by the NACC Regional Office to support the implementation of Accident and Incident Investigation (AIG) in the region, as well as the current status of AIG implementation in the NAM/CAR Region. The discussion will cover compliance with ICAO Annex 13 provisions, the availability of independent and adequately resourced investigation authorities, and the degree of regional cooperation in sharing expertise, key challenges, and lessons learned.

Agenda Item 6: Analysis of ANS Effective Implementation in the NAM/CAR Region and challenges/Navigation Aids & Flight inspections

Under this agenda item, the Secretariat will discuss the effective implementation of the NACC USOAP Air Navigation Services (ANS), based on the recent results of the ICAO USOAP and related evaluations. The analysis will highlight areas of strength and persistent gaps, including deficiencies in regulatory frameworks, supervisory processes, and technical staff. The session will also outline regional trends and specific challenges affecting the supervision and delivery of ANS services. Additionally, Protocol Questions (PQs) relating to air aid and flight inspections will be presented as part of the assessments carried out during USOAP activities.

Agenda Item 7: RSOO support for strengthening Safety Oversight: ACSA's Technical Support to States, USOAP Challenges, and Regulatory Harmonization Efforts and CASSOS updates.

Under this agenda item the importance of Regional Safety Oversight Organization (RSOO) for strengthening Safety Oversight, will be shared. RSOO like COCESNA /ACSA will present the role of the organization in providing technical support to Central American States, particularly in preparation for and follow-up of ICAO USOAP activities, highlighting highlight common challenges faced by States during USOAP audits, lessons learned by the RSOO from recent experiences, and the strategies being applied to overcome these obstacles. In addition, the ACSA will outline progress on the regional regulatory harmonization project, aimed at strengthening oversight capabilities, ensuring consistency in regulatory frameworks, and promoting more effective collaboration across the region. Additionally, the secretariat will present updates regarding CASSOS developments.

Agenda Item 8: States' experiences on the 2025 USOAP Audit, Lessons Learned and Challenges

Under this agenda item, States will share their experiences on the 2025 USOAP Audits. from the preparation activities for the 2025 USOAP audit, summarizing the milestones achieved, lessons learned from the process, and challenges encountered. The discussion will highlight practical experiences and provide insights that can benefit other NAM/CAR States in strengthening their own audit readiness and oversight systems.

Agenda Item 9: Review of NCMC/WG Work program 2025-2027, and other administrative matters

Under this agenda item the meeting will review its Terms of Reference, membership and work programme for 2025–2027, outlining priority activities and deliverables to support the continued implementation of safety initiatives in the NAM/CAR Region. The secretariat will present the changes in the NCMC/WG webpage under NACC Website. In addition, based on the ToRs, the election of new rapporteurs representing both Spanish- and English-speaking States shall be made, ensuring balanced leadership and effective coordination of the Working Group.
