Dear Sir/Madam,

One of the recommendations from States From previous CAR/SAM Air Transport related events was the need of technical guidance and assistance for the timely and proper implementation of ICAO's Policies on Charges for airports and Air Navigation Services (ANS), and incorporate the four key charging principles, i.e. non-discrimination, cost-relatedness, transparency and consultation with users, into their national legislation and regulation. In doing so, it is essential to take into consideration the financial sustainability of airports and Air Navigation Service Providers (ANSPs), as well as their ability to invest in infrastructure, safety, and capacity to maintain high-quality services and support the long-term development of air transport in the region.

The application of charges encompasses the main elements of ICAO's Policies on Charges for Airports and Air Navigation Services (Doc 9082), including the foundations of the policies set out in Article 15 of the Chicago Convention, the four key charging principles, and the main recommendations on determining cost basis, establishing charging system and developing individual charges. The perspectives and discussion among regulators, airport operators, ANSPs, airlines/users, and other stakeholders are key for the comprehensive application of the ICAO policies and guidance.

In this regard, the ICAO North American, Central American and Caribbean (NACC) Regional Office and the South American Regional Office together with ACI-LAC, ALTA, CANSO, IATA, and LACAC, are pleased to invite your Administration to participate in the NAM/CAR/SAM Workshop on Airport and Air Navigation User Charges, to be held at the NACC Regional Office in Mexico City from 10 to 12 August 2026.

This workshop aims at supporting States in enhancing their knowledge of ICAO's policies on charges for airports and Air Navigation Services (ANS) and to further strengthen their implementation. It also seeks to deepen their understanding of cost structures, international policies, transparency requirements, and best practices related to the establishment and oversight of airport and Air Navigation Services (ANS) user charges. In addition, the event aims to raise awareness of the socio-economic benefits of promoting appropriate economic policies and regulatory predictability in favour of a robust and liberalized air transport market.

Sharing relevant experiences and best practices by States and industry will enrich the discussions and outcomes of the workshop. The programme will be available shortly and it will include presentations, case studies, and group discussions focused on user charges and economic oversight with practical exercises and harmonized implementation across the NAM/CAR Regions.

The profile of the participants is of utmost relevance; therefore, participation of specialists in charge of air transport regulation and economic oversight, as well as charges in civil aviation authorities, airports, and Air Navigation Service Providers (ANSPs) is highly recommended.
